_____ Hispanic: Persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American or other Spanish cultures or origin, regardless of race.

_____ White (Not of Hispanic Origin): Persons having origins in any of the origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North America, or Middle East.

_____ American Indian or Alaskan: Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintain cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

_____ Native Hawaiian: Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii.

_____ Asian or Pacific Islander: Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent. The area includes, for example, China, Japan, Korea, Cambodia, India, Thailand, Vietnam, and Pakistan. Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Guam, Samoa, the Philippine Islands, or other Pacific Islands.
