



Subject: Eliminate Lab Science Specification (BIOL 101) from Core Requirements  
for B.S. in Criminal Justice Degree

The Department of Criminal Justice and Paralegal Studies proposes dropping the specific requirement of BIOL 101 as one of the lab sciences required for the BS Degree in Criminal Justice. This matter was discussed and formally voted on (approved) by the faculty at the 9/13/05 Departmental faculty meeting.

The current BS degree in Criminal Justice requirements specify that CJ majors must take BIOL 101 as one of their lab sciences. This requirement was put into place because this course was listed as a pre-requisite for SOCW 102 Introduction to Social Work. We are proposing (in a separate memo) concurrently that SOCW 102 be deleted from core requirements for the BS in Criminal Justice. Therefore the specific designation of this lab science is no longer required.
