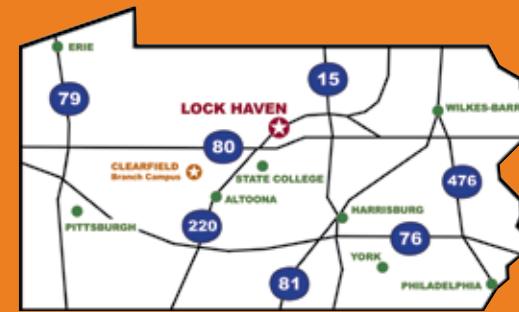

Directions to Lock Haven University

From Interstate 80, Exit 178

(Lock Haven University sign) Follow Rt. 220 North for approx. 8 miles to the Lock Haven exit. Turn left at the stop light just off the ramp and follow signs for 120 West and to the LHU campus (about 1 mile).

Access to I-80

From Philadelphia - Turnpike to 476 North, NE Extension to Exit 95 (Pocono exit) to I-80 West.
From Washington, D.C. - I-83 North to Rt. 581 to Rt. 11/15 North to Rt. 15 North to I-80 West.
From Northwestern PA - I-79 South to I-80 East
From Northeastern PA - I-81 South to I-80 West.
From Southeastern PA - I-83 North to Rt. 322 West to Rt. 11/15 North to Rt. 15 north to I-80.

From Southwestern Pennsylvania

Rt. 22 East to Rt. 220 north (I-99) to Rt. 150 to Lock Haven. Halfway down the hill past the Ford dealership, turn left onto the LHU campus.

While you're here visiting us, you may want to check out some of our area attractions. Here is a sampling:

Shopping

Downtown Lock Haven has a variety of shops and other services. In addition, you can shop at nearby **Lycoming Mall** in Muncy or **Nittany Mall** in State College. The world-famous **Woolrich Factory Outlet** is just a few minutes away in McElhatten with discounts on top quality outdoor clothing.

Attractions

The Clinton County Historical Museum houses the history of our county over the past 200+ years.

The Farrandville Iron Furnace, about 5 miles from Lock Haven was the first and largest coke-fired hot blast furnace in North America.

The Thomas T. Taber Museum in Williamsport features not only area historical artifacts on display, but also the Shepp Model Train collection and the Rosen Art Collection.

The Piper Aviation Museum exhibits Piper airplanes, artifacts and films about aircraft and aviation.

The Heisey Museum in Lock Haven displays farming, household, logging & canal memorabilia from the 19th century.

The art deco **Roxy Theatre**, built in the 1920's in downtown Lock Haven shows first-run films.

The Community Arts Center in Williamsport hosts a wide variety of touring shows and entertainment.

The Millbrook Playhouse hosts professional summer stock performances.

Parks & Recreation

Our area, called "The Wilds" is filled with opportunities for outdoor recreation. Clinton County has five state parks/forests offering fishing, boating, hunting, skiing, hiking, bicycling, snowmobiling and more.
