Scholarship Name	Amount	Requirements
Bonnie K. Frantz Scholarship	\$400	For an incoming freshman female majoring in theatre.
Dr. & Mrs. Arthur William Phillips Scholarship	\$1,000	For an incoming freshman student residing in Butler, Clarion, Forest, Jefferson, Lawrence, Mercer or Venango Counties.
Ira O. "Pop" Fleming Memorial Scholarship	\$300	For an incoming freshman student majoring in science. Recipient must also be a resident of one of the following counties: Elk, Warren or Clinton.
James Taft Williams Memorial Scholarship	\$300	For an incoming first-time freshman student majoring in Science (Biology/Chemistry). Recipient must be a resident of Mifflin County.
Margaret Wolfe Memorial Scholarship	\$450	For an incoming freshman student residing in Loganton Borough, Greene Twp., or Logan Twp.
Alfred Hoberman Scholarship	\$1,400/yr	For an incoming freshman student majoring in chemistry.
Edward Hoberman Scholarship	\$475	For a Central Mountain High School graduate who will be majoring in one of the natural science disciplines including chemistry, biology, physics, or geology. Recipient must have at least a B average and financial need.
Dr. George & Shirley Durrwachter Scholarship	\$650	Recipient must be a recent graduate of Jersey Shore High School, who will be enrolled as a full-time student at LHU, majoring in a health related field, such as Health and Physical Education, Health Science, Nursing, Pre-Prof, or Athletic Training, etc.
Mona Managan Memorial Nursing Scholarship	\$300	Minimum 2.5 GPA. Major in nursing from Central Mountain High School. Selection: Central Mountain High School Guidance Office in consultation with the Lock Haven University Admissions Office.
Highmark Scholarship (10 available)	\$1,000	Students must be enrolled to pursue a degree in the field of healthcare. Students must agree to permit the Foundation and Highmark to use his/her photograph, quotations and other information in promotional materials if requested.
Nanotechnology Scholarship** (15 available)	Up to full tuition (renewable for up to 4 years)	Must major in biology, chemistry, biology-chemistry, geology, physics, 4+2 engineering, or computer science. This scholarship is based on academic merit and financial need. Recipients must complete two courses in nanotechnology at LHU and a summer at Penn State University's nanofabrication facility, at no cost to the student. Recipients of this scholarship must participate in the Honors Program during his/her first year.
Freshman Year Alumni Scholarship** (22 available)	\$2,000	This scholarship is for incoming freshmen graduating in the top 10% of their class with a challenging academic curriculum and a SAT score of at least an 1100 (critical reading & math sections only).
FROMM Family Scholarship** (3 available)	\$1,000	This scholarship is for incoming freshmen graduating in the top 15% of their class with a challenging academic curriculum and a SAT score of at least a 1000 (critical reading and math sections only).

Eve Scholarship	\$750	For an incoming freshman student residing in Blair County <u>other than</u> Altoona (This scholarship is need-based).
James A. Hughes Scholarship	\$1,500	This scholarship is awarded to an incoming first-time freshman student of any high school or charter school within the Philadelphia School District. <b>Students must complete the application online at <a href="http://www.thepafoundation.org">www.thepafoundation.org</a></b> (This scholarship is need-based). It is also renewable for sophomores, juniors, and seniors.
Stayman Scholarship	\$1,000	For an incoming freshman student residing in Blair County. The student <u>must live in</u> Altoona. (This scholarship is need-based).
