

Guidelines for AFSCME Local 2360 Scholarship Committee

1. The Scholarship Committee will consist of volunteer members of Local 2360. Each member will serve on this committee until he/she expresses a desire to be replaced, at which time the membership will ask for another volunteer.
2. A scholarship will be made available to any member, spouse, child, or grandchild of a member who is or will be enrolled in college or trade school after completion of their high school education.
3. The spouse, children and/or employees of Lock Haven University (if they will be attending LHU) are not eligible for an AFSCME, Local 2360 scholarship. If he/she already receives a tuition waiver.
4. The money for the scholarship fund will come from the vending money received from our agreement with the SCC. The amount of the award will be determined by the committee and available funds and scholarships will be awarded for a period of two (2) years only.

6. Applications for scholarships must be submitted to the scholarship committee **no later than July 1** of each calendar year. Application submitted after that date will not be considered for that calendar year.
7. Scholarships will be awarded directly to the institution where the recipient is enrolled so that the scholarship can be applied to his/her tuition.
8. The main objective of the scholarship is to help those recipients who show a need for financial aid.
