## #21 MINUTES

APSCUF representatives present were: Mark Cloud, Kelley Green, Heather Kendra, Andrew Waeger, Pat Rudy, and Cheryl Orndorf as recording secretary.

Management representatives present were: Roger Johnson, Tara Fulton, Kim Powell, and Denise Shoemaker.

Sharon Taylor was invited by APSCUF and attended.

### **I. Approval of Meeting Minutes**

The approval of the minutes of the November 14, 2006 meeting was postponed.

### **II. Grievance Update**

There were no changes.

### **III. Athletic Facilities Study Committee**

There will now be two coaches; one from men's sports and one from women's sports, and two faculty members on the committee. The charge is being revised. R. Johnson will provide M. Cloud with a new draft of the charge that includes some suggestions for a more broad charge and the language will be finalized through that venue.

### **IV. FLSA Responses Across the System**

APSCUF reported West Chester is approving all overtime during season, Shippensburg allows 25% increase in hours, Bloomsburg allows 10 additional hours per week, IUP set aside overtime money to be used until exhausted, and Millersville allows up to 20 additional hour per person for in season total. APSCUF asked can if we can find a similar model to provide the needed flexibility for our assistant and head coaches? Management responded yes. While there have been no requests for overtime, a system for dealing with it would be appropriate. If we come up with a system for paying overtime in this AY, something else will have to be decreased to cover it. There will be budget hearings held toward the end of the spring semester to plan for next year.

### **V. Spring Tryouts**

APSCUF reported the coaches in W. Soccer, M. Soccer, W. Basketball, M. Basketball, and Softball seek to begin having spring tryouts. APSCUF requests management to allow this NCAA approved recruiting tool to be utilized for these sports. Management has no policy regarding spring tryouts. However, management supports the decision of the AD on this issue. There will be some discussions and a response will be given before the next meeting. The coaches are open to doing this on a trial basis as an additional recruiting tool to expand how far their dollars go.

### **VI. Power Outage and Softball Tournaments**

APSCUF asked if there is any possibility to delay closing in May by two days so Softball could host the NCAA Regional Championship. Our National Champion Softball team would like to be able to utilize all the advantages a national championship brings towards repeating their excellence. They are willing to work out anything in terms of facilities to have this opportunity. Management will get back on this issue.

### **VII. Spring Meetings**

The spring meeting schedule will be Tuesdays 8:00-9:00 a.m. in the Executive Board Room January 30, February 20, March 20, April 17, May 15, 2007.

APSCUF thanked management for the resolution to have the second car. It has been very helpful.
