

The Local Negotiations Committee met on Friday, October 21, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. at the APSCUF Office.

Those present were: Jamie Foor, Tara Mitchell and Gerard Rozea.

Those not present were: Kim Alexander and Sue Ann Schatz.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the upcoming forum meetings with Bill Chabala. Gerard Rozea sent an email via the faculty list describing the various faculty opportunities to meet and discuss concerns for the upcoming contract negotiations on Monday, October 17, 2005. A follow-up email was also sent Thursday, October 20, 2005. All faculty members were invited to express interest in attending one of the two forums to be held. We hoped to have at least 24 faculty members express interest, so that there would be at least 12 people at each of the two meetings. This goal was not met. The Committee discussed ways to recruit additional people to attend the forums.

It was decided that each Committee member would attempt to recruit 1 – 2 people to attend the forums. Mark Cloud was also asked to send out another email encouraging participation in the forums. The revised deadline to recruit people for the forums will be before the next Committee meeting on Tuesday, October 25, 2005.

The Committee also discussed concerns and issues for the negotiations that had been provided by APSCUF members, including Professional Leave, Sabbatical Leave, cost of living increases, health benefits, summer pay, and moving expenses. A more complete list of these issues will be distributed to the Committee members by email.
