

*Minutes of Management/APSCUF Coaches' Meet & Discuss*

11:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 2, 2008

Meeting #29 was called to order at 11:03 a.m. in Rom 212, Health Professions Bld.

Minutes of July 22, 2008 meeting were approved

Roger Johnson turned the meeting over to Albert Jones who presented a proposed schedule for athletic head coaches and associate/assistant coaches' annual evaluations as per APSCUF coaches' contract, Article 23. The proposed evaluation schedule that management presented was based on the NCAA's start date for each sport. Based on that, pre-evaluation meetings were scheduled, and annual evaluations were proposed to be held "within 15 days of the conclusion of NCAA Division II championship game".

Sharon Taylor opined that if we want to evaluate on the basis of 12 months, then we should evaluate at the end of the year.

Roger Johnson replied, "Sharon, give us the dates you like, and we'll firm them up and give you the dates you like."

By or before June 30<sup>th</sup> was set for evaluation. It was noted that we're behind already. We should do pre-evaluations as early as possible for fall sports.

Pat Rudy inquired as to the grievance and where it was in the process of arbitration

The next meeting was set for Wednesday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> at 11 a.m. in the Health Professions Building, Room 212.

Sharon stated that we should list a date for each sport's pre-evaluation and do it by that date.

Heather Davis asked if everyone could be done by August 1<sup>st</sup> for pre-evaluations and by June 30<sup>th</sup> for post-evaluations.

Sharon stated that we could do post-evaluations for 1 year, ending, and pre-evaluations for the next year in one meeting, say, by June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Pat mentioned that according to the CBA, this evaluation is only for merit consideration in the CBA.

The meeting was adjourned by Fay Cook at 11:32 a.m.
