- I. **Minutes of September 2, 2008 were approved.**

Sharon Taylor brought up the signed agreement that was a 5 year agreement with a 3 year buffer phase in.

Concerns were voiced by Doug Moore on getting people to come back to his camps now that he has lost groups to other camps such as Penn State and Bucknell. He didn't know if he could get enough to make up his buyout.
