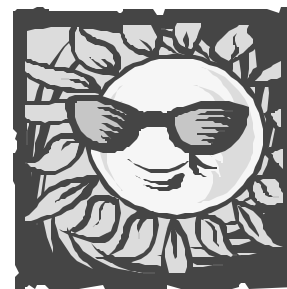
### Lock Haven Faculty Member (*Bruce Young*) Receives APSCUF Distinguished Service Award
