Her schedule will include: a table in the PUB from 10 a.m. to 12 noon, a visit to POLI 330 Public Policy at 12:20 (in the Hall of Flags--visitors are welcome), and a visit to the Honors House at 1:30.

If you would like Ms. Hutchinson to give a presentation to your class or student group, let me know. It is very likely that we can fit your class or meeting into her schedule.

**About TWC:** TWC works on behalf of affiliated colleges and universities to provide semester and summer internship experiences in Washington. They place students in government agencies, private firms, and non-profit associations on the basis of the students' academic and career interests. They accept students from all majors. LHU students in Social Work, Criminal Justice, Business Administration, and Political Science have participated in recent semesters. (As with other internships, academic credit requires approval from the student's advisor and the department granting credit.)

LHU students are eligible for \$4500 scholarships to defray part of the TWC program and housing costs. TWC requires that the student be eligible for internship credits on the home campus, which means being registered for credit at LHU. Despite this "double billing," the scholarship makes the cost of a summer internship with TWC roughly comparable to paying tuition, room, and board on campus for a fall or spring semester.
