Computing Environment

Our programming contest will be held in our two labs in Akeley Hall. One is a teaching lab and the other is an open lab. The rooms are AK203, and AK205. Each room is equipped with 25 personal computers running Windows XP with service pack 2 installed. The software installed on these machines includes: Visual Studio2005.NET (C++), Eclipse 3.2 (Advanced Java environment), JDK 1.5.

Friday Evening

Teams will meet immediately after the keynote speech Friday evening and be taken to Akeley Hall for directions on using our machines and a practice session with one sample problem. This practice session should last approximately one hour. After the practice session, teams will be treated to pizza.

Saturday Morning
