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Recommended work: (please include location and detailed scope of work)

1. Bicycle rack at Zimmerli along sidewalk that connects Akeley to Zim.
Students have their bikes tied to whatever tree might be open.
2. Large parking lot across from Sloan there is a former construction site where there is still a lot of debris, odds, ends, weeds, etc. Maybe some topsoil and grass seed.
3. Former Sullivan parking lot – I know it is owned by the City, but it would be nice to work out something with them to allow for benches and some planters at the trolley stop, get rid of the yellow tape and possibly put in some curbing, fill it in with dirt to make it look less like a former parking lot at the far end where the trolley does not stop.
4. Glennon Building – the plantings next to Glennon by Glenn Road need a little TLC. There are gaps in the planting where dead bushes were taken out and a dead tree, but nothing was put in to replace and it just looks a little shabby.
