Note: This letter must be stamped with the college's seal.

Please be advised that, if your sibling is enrolled in a Master's or Doctoral degree program, s/he cannot be included as a household member in a college on your FAFSA. Federal regulations state that dependent students may only include individuals seeking undergraduate degrees as household members in college.

Also note that parents of dependent students cannot be counted in the number in college on the student's FAFSA.
