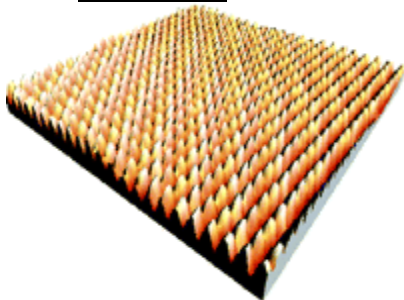
Topic: "PDMS as a Medium for Motile Bacterium"

presented by Seth Nyman

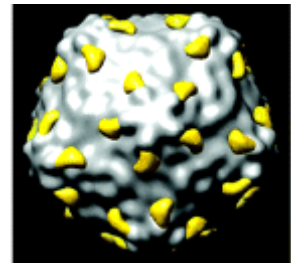
