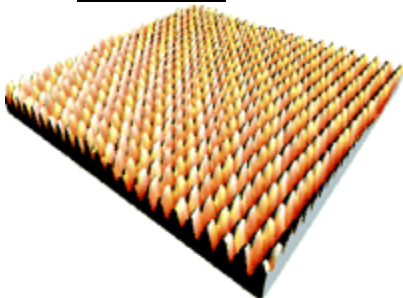
Topic: " Identification of the presence of adrenergic receptors on bovine sperm"

presented by Alysia DePasquale, supervised by Dr. Amy Way

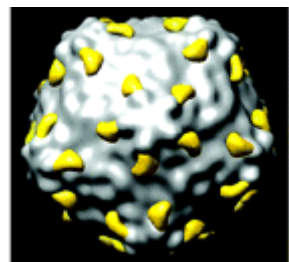
