

Nanotechnology Seminar Series

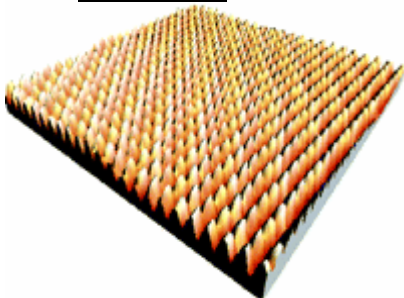

Topic: Dr. C. Howell, Dr. D. Jia, and Dr. M. Tzolov are presenting a summary of their proposals for the FPDC annual grant program

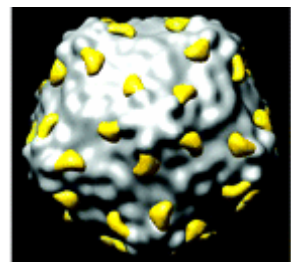
