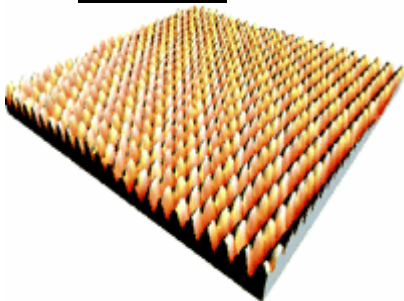
Topic: “Monolayer Laser Diffraction”

presented by Shawn Pickering, supervised by Dr. D. Jia

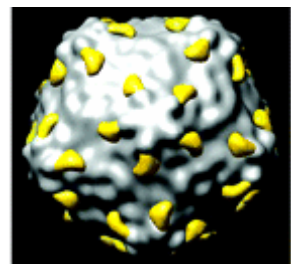
Abstract: Monolayers made of different sized microspheres were created and analyzed with laser beam diffraction. The diffraction pattern was analyzed and the spacing between the bright spots was correlated with the size of the microspheres and the wavelength of the laser light.
