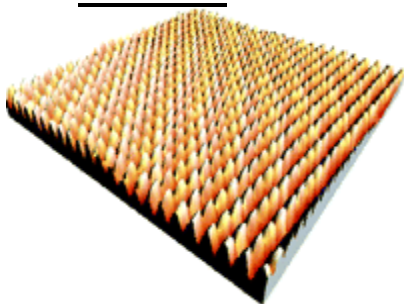
Topic: "The Rise and Fall of Silicon Dioxide".

presented by Dr. Osama O. Awadelkarim

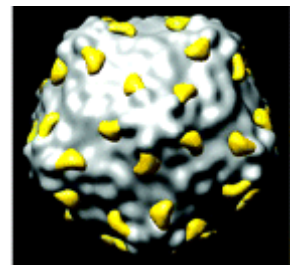
