## Special meeting

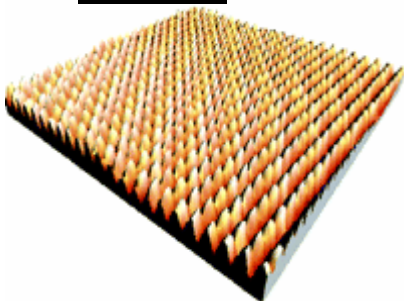

Presented by: Justin Ingram

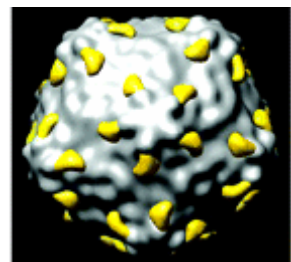
