Understanding German Culture: Presentation at Lock Haven University

Lock Haven- The Institute for International Studies of Lock Haven University will host a lecture on traditional German customs and modern culture. Dr. Christoph Ribbat, a professor of American literature and culture at the University of Paderborn, Germany, will give his presentation on Monday, October 3, 2011 at 7:00 pm in 425 Raub Hall on the campus of Lock Haven University. This event is free and open to the public.

Dr. Ribbat's main research areas include contemporary fiction, the history of photography and visual culture, and 20th century cultural history. He has conducted research as a Feodor Lynen Fellow at M.I.T and Boston University, a Fulbright Scholar at the Cooper Union, New York, and an Ansel Adams Fellow at the Center for Creative Photography, Tucson.
