GRE prep course at Lock Haven University

Considering graduate school? Lock Haven University will host a Graduate Record Exam (GRE) preparation course that Career Services on October 15-16, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. in Raub Hall, room 422.

This preparation course for the GRE will be taught by Dr. James Yoho of Yoho Test Preparation. Yoho has been teaching highly-regarded test preparation since 1996 at universities such as Penn State, La Salle, Lehigh, Seton Hall, Emory, Marist and Temple. During that time, he has coached some 10,000 test-takers on the GRE and similar tests.

The GRE is, essentially, a test of general reasoning ability. The preparation course will help provide test-takers with a clear understanding of the types of reasoning that are tested and a sensible procedural approach to the test. These procedures will be rehearsed on real GRE questions. Questions about course content can be sent to yohoprep@aol.com.

Those who register by October 11 will pay \$335. Registration is also available after October 11 for a fee of \$360.
