LHU students mobilize to Make A Difference National Day of Service draws 100 student volunteers

Despite the snow and freezing drizzle, approximately 100 Lock Haven University students came out on Saturday, October 29 to participate in Make A Difference Day, which is a national day of service.

Students assisted in organizing and cleaning at the food pantry at the Salvation Army, worked on construction projects at the Life Center, and assisted Clinton County Cleanscapes with a roadside clean-up on Farrandsville Road as well as Glenn Road. Participating student organizations include Sigma Sigma Sigma, Kappa Delta Rho, Health Science Club, LHU AmeriCorps, Alpha Chi Rho, Outreach for Humanity, Phi Sigma Pi, and the University Honors Program.



The event was coordinated by LHU student AmeriCorps members Jessica Huff and Danielle Yarnell. They serve as AmeriCorps members with LHU's MountainServe Center for Global Citizenship.
