Lock Haven University's Physician Assistant Program has a top-25 position in U.S. News and World Report's 2012 edition of Best Colleges. The 2012 Best Colleges Guidebook will be on newsstands September 20.

In March, the LHU PA Program was awarded 25th place among PA programs nationwide in U.S. News and World Report's Best Graduate Schools 2012.

Anna Mae Smith, director of the LHU PA Program, said "This mark of distinction and recognition, in addition to a 100% pass rate for the class of 2011, is a testament to the quality of the education we provide to our students." She added, "Due to the dedication of our faculty, administration and, most importantly, the hard work of our students, LHU's PA Program is ranked 25 out of 156 PA programs nationwide."
