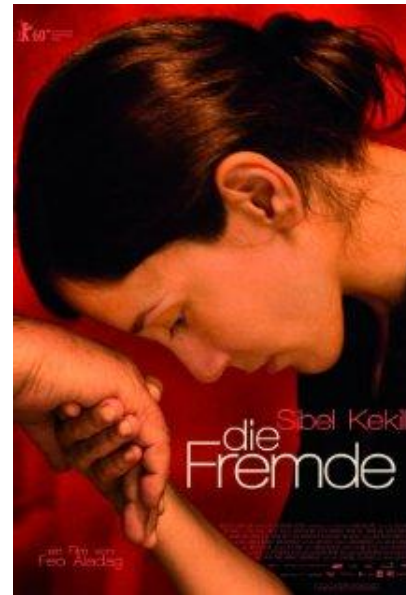

International film "When We Leave" will be shown at the Hope Center

LOCK HAVEN, PA-Lock Haven University's Institute for International Studies, in conjunction with The Hope Center and Women's Studies, will present the German film "When We Leave" as the next film in the international film series. This film is unrated. The film will be shown on Thursday, November 10 from 6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. in The Hope Center located in East Campus Room G204 of Lock Haven University. There will be a discussion following the film. This event is free and open to the public.

The film revolves around Umay, a young woman of Turkish descent, fighting for an independent and self-determined life in Germany against the resistance of her family. Her family is trapped in their conventions, torn between their love for her and the traditional values of their community. Her struggle initiates a dynamic, which results in a life-threatening situation.
