LHU will host Assistive Technology Fair:
Demonstrations and information on technologies to assist individuals with disabilities

Assistive technologies make it possible for persons with disabilities to perform tasks they could not accomplish otherwise, or that they would have difficulty performing. Community members who are interested in knowing the various assistive technologies available in Pennsylvania are invited to Lock Haven University's 5th Annual Fair on Assistive Technology. The Fair will take place on Friday, October 14 in the PUB Multipurpose room from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

The Fair will provide the opportunity to see the latest in assistive technology in action. Lock Haven University students will demonstrate various assistive devices for individuals with different disabilities. LHU students have also prepared informative posters and will be on hand to answer questions and give information.

Those attending the Fair will also have an opportunity to meet with parents and other individuals with interest in assistive technologies. In addition, participants will learn how to get assistive technology on loan in Pennsylvania.
