Child Protection in Scotland

Lock Haven University and the Institute for International Students present a lecture by John McGowan, member of the British Association of Social Workers and a faculty member of the Open University, entitled, "Child Protection in Scotland." The lecture will be held on the campus of Lock Haven University in the Greenberg Auditorium in the Health Professions Building on Wednesday, September 28 at 6:00 pm. This event is free and open to the public.

McGowan, who holds a Master of Science in Social Work Studies and a Bachelor of Arts in Social Science from Glasgow Caledonian University in Scotland, provides training to undergraduates in a variety of themes including risk assessment, child protection, conflict resolution, parenting, anger management, skills to foster, and managing behavior workshops. He also conducts independent social work assessments such as one-on-one work with children and families.

McGowan is not a stranger to Lock Haven University. He studies at LHU as an international exchange student in 1996. He was an active member of the International Student Association (ISA) and played intramural soccer on the ISA team.
