Lock Haven University Dance Concert will offer “something for everyone”  
Concert will showcase a variety of styles, over 100 dancers

The Lock Haven University Performing Arts Department will stage their Fall Dance Concert on December 2 and December 3 at 7:00 p.m., with a matinee performance on December 3 at 3:00 p.m. All performances will be in the Sloan Auditorium.

Over 100 Lock Haven University dancers will take the stage to present a myriad of dance works choreographed by faculty and students as well as guest choreographers.

This season’s concert is filled with variety styles, including ballet, contemporary technique, Tap, salsa, hip-hop, and Broadway-styled jazz.

“Smitten” is a light-hearted ballet choreographed about the whimsical pursuit of a suitor.

Guest choreographer Mark Lingenfelter created a group work, Broadway musical, for the concert.

Juniors Barbara Wojtowich and Alexis Pavolik co-choreographed “Speaking in Tongues,” a work exploring the genre of tap and the power of syncopated rhythms.

Senior Alexis Garcia has created a Latin-flavored dance of samba and salsa styles, entitled, "Hip Hip Chin Chin.”

According to Professor of Dance Jayme Klinger Host, this is just a small sampling of what the audience will see. “There is, as always, a wide variety of styles so there is literally ‘something for everyone,’” she said.

Two classes from the Fourth Grade at Dickey Elementary School will be performing as part of a special matinee Lecture/Demonstration performance on Friday December 2 at 12:45. The audience will be filled with 300 faculty and students from Dickey Elementary. The two fourth grades will be performing dances taught to them from Professor Host’s course DANC300.01: Dance Integration for Elementary Education.

Tickets are required for all performances. They can be picked up on the night of performances; however, patrons are required to contact the Box Office in advance.
