### ALL-STAR CANDIDATES

#### *Joe Walker (Sr., F, 6-5, 205, Lock Haven, Pa./Central Mountain)*

Walker was a Second-Team All-PSAC West selection a year ago and will provide senior leadership on the post this season. He led the Bald Eagles in points in four games a year ago, including dropping 26 points on Kutztown University.

#### *James Chappell (So., G, 5-11, 150, Coatesville, Pa./Coatesville Area)*

Chappell paced the team in scoring in nine different contests in 2003-04, including the 76-75 win at Slippery Rock.

### TEAM NOTES

Sixth-year head coach John Wilson's Bald Eagles retain three of their five starters including Second-Team All-PSAC West selection Joe Walker.

Lock Haven will send a young team to the court. Outside of the five seniors, LHU has three freshmen and seven sophomores, including leading scorer James Chappell.

The Bald Eagles travel up Rt. 64 to Division I Penn State University this season, the 10th meeting between the two schools. The Nittany Lions hold a 9-0 advantage, including the most recent win in 1985.

LHU will feature some size this season, with five players at 6-foot-5 and above.
