The Game:

The Lock Haven University football team opens their 2008 season at home field, Thursday night Aug. 28th, against NCAA D-II, Glenville State College.

The game will be played at LHU's Hubert Jack Stadium with the kick off set for 7 p.m. The game marks the season opener for both teams.

This will be the first meeting between LHU and GSC.

2008 Season Notes:

Lock Haven head coach John Klacik, a 1988 LHU graduate enters his fourth season at the helm of the Bald Eagles looking for a winning season. He will look to lead a young, but experienced squad that returns 14 starters and 34 letter winners. Klacik, who is 5-28 over his first three years, also welcomes a strong cast of newcomers all of who will look to make their mark.

There's some experience on the offensive side of the ball with quarterback Ilio DiPaolo and running back Ibrahim Smith returning. DiPaolo will be in his third year starting after completing 86 of 172 passes a year ago for 723 yards and three touchdowns. Smith enjoyed a solid rookie campaign rushing for a team-high 520 yards and scoring a team-high six touchdowns.

The Haven's defense returns solid experience in the form of eight starters. Leading the way will be Shane Barie, who is the leading returning tackler. He was second on the team last season with 75, while Shawn Crebs also returns after recording 64 tackles a year ago. LHU has five guys returning with 35 plus tackles from last year.

Hubert Jack Stadium will have a new look this year, featuring brand new artificial field turf for the '08 season.



2008 All-Star Candidates

ILIO DIPAOLO (QB, Jr., 5-11, 180, Orchard Park, N.Y./St. Francis):

DiPaolo will be under center for the third straight year as a starter. Last season he passed for 723 yards and three touchdowns. He was 86 of 172 and threw nine picks. He also rushed for 217 yards and one touchdown. Quick and athletic, DiPaolo is a two-way threat, able to pass and run which adds a valuable options to LHU's offense.

IBRAHIM SMITH (RB, So., 6-0, 190, New Bloomfield, Pa./ West Perry):

Enjoyed a strong rookie season leading the team in rushing with 520 yards and six touchdowns. Strong and speedy Smith will look to make his second season a special one as he looks to lead the Haven's ground attack.

SHANE BARIE (DB, Jr., 5-10, 180, Export, Pa./Franklin Regional):

Team's leading returning tackler. Was second on the team a year ago with 75 (41 UT & 34 AT). Strong, quick and athletic Barie will be a major key in Lock Haven's game plan.

SHAWN CREBS (LB, Sr., 6-0, 220, Lewisburg, Pa./ Lewisburg): Crebs made 64 tackles a year ago including 35 unassisted and 29 assisted. Will look to use his solid speed and strong athletic frame to help anchor the Haven's defensive unit.

DEMARR DOWELL (WR, Sr. 6-2, 195, Buffalo, N.Y./Erie): Team's leading receiver returning. Only played in six games, but made 21 catches for 278 yards and three touchdowns. Will look to be a major offensive threate for the Bald Ealges this season as they look to get the passing game going.

MARK DOMONKOS (PK, Jr. 5-8, 185, Windber, Pa./Bishop McCort): Put his powerful foot to work kicking field goals in 10 games for the Haven. He converted on 9 of 13 tries through the up-rights with his longest boot of 39 yards coming against Slippery Rock. He will look to continue to help the Haven put points on the board during the 2008 season. Returning place kicker will be a big part of the Haven's offense.

BRENDON PICKLE(P, Sr. 6-3, 220, Easton, Pa./Easton): Set a Lock Haven single season record with 81 punts, good for 3140 yards. His 38.80 yards per punt ranked fifth in school history. He now ranks fifth in all-time punting yards with 5527. He was second in the NCAA with 81 punt attempts. His longest punt of the season was 69 yards against Shippensburg. His powerful foot will be a critical part of the Haven's 2008 season.

LHU's Last Time Out:

CLARION, Pa. – The Lock Haven University Football team avoided its first winless season in 56 years as they defeated the Clarion University Golden Eagles in overtime by a 17-14 margin. Clarion looked to get on the board early as they marched down field easily only to have a 30 yard field goal attempt fall short and keep the game scoreless. Clarion scored in the second quarter as quarterback Tyler Huether powered in from the goal line on a one yard QB keeper to give the Golden Eagles the lead. Kicker Nick Sipes boot cleared the uprights to make the score 7-0. Following a possession by each team LHU would get the ball back with great field position and would capitalize on it as five plays later running back Ibrahim Smith crossed the plane of the end zone.

Haven kicker Marc Domonkos' PAT would be good to tie the game up at 7-7. As the two teams came from the locker room it became a defensive struggle in the third quarter as both teams were unable to put on points on

the scoreboard. LHU had a great opportunity to take the lead as following a muffed Brendon Pickle punt the Bald Eagles had great field position at the Golden Eagle 25, but they were unable to do much with it as they had to settle for a field goal attempt from Domonkos. Domonkos' kick would sail wide left keeping the score at a 7-7 deadlock. Lock Haven would waste no time scoring in the fourth quarter as 11 seconds into the frame Smith would scamper 64 yards to the end zone to give The Haven the 14-7 lead following Domonkos' PAT. Each team would trade possessions until with 8:30 to go quarter number four Clarion would get possession and march downfield on a ten play 89 yard drive which resulted in a touchdown. Running Back Eddie Emmanuel barreled one yard up the middle for the score which became tied again following Sipes second extra point of the day.

Lock Haven would have one last ditch effort to win the game in regulation as quarterback Ilio DiPaolo would find Chris Hawkins 39 yards downfield but time would expire before the LHU coaches could get the timeout in sending the game to overtime. The Bald Eagle defense pushed Clarion backwards and the Golden Eagles had to settle for a field goal attempt. Sipes' 47 yard attempt would be short of the mark for the second time of the day setting Lock Haven up for the win. LHU's possession would start at the Clarion 25 and four plays later culminate with a 35 yard boot from the nearside hash. Third time would be a charm for Domonkos as his field goal would clear the uprights to give Lock Haven their first victory of the year.

Leading the way on the ground for Lock Haven was Smith who carried the ball 22 times for 139 yards and two touchdowns. His 139 yards and two touchdowns are the best of his young career. Through the air DiPaolo and Tyler Golden combined to be 15 of 22 for 184 yards. DiPaolo had a stellar performance going 10-15 for 97 yards and Golden also put up strong numbers as he went 5-7 for 87 yards in only one quarter of work. On the receiving end junior Damar Dowell had four catches for 60 yards. Defensively LHU was led by Mike Nesby's eight tackles and Corey Gildea's five tackles on the day gave him 100 on the season.
