Bringing with him 17 years of Division I and I-AA coaching experience, **John Klacik** enters his third season at the helm of the Bald Eagle football program.

With two full recruiting classes under his belt, Klacik now looks to turn the page, as the Bald Eagles are looking to take the next step under his guidance. LHU will return plenty of

the experience, with 17 starters and a strong recruiting class.

After going 2-9 each of his first two seasons at the helm of the Bald Eagles Klacik is looing for the team to take a huge step forward.

Klacik, an LHU alum has spent all but one season of his coaching career at Youngstown State University, and was a part of four NCAA I-AA National Championship teams. He started with the Penguins as tight ends coach, working his way up the ladder through the offense, moving to wide receivers, quarterbacks, offensive line and then as offensive coordinator for the last four seasons. Klacik worked under current Ohio State University head coach Jim Tressel for 12 years.

A standout wide receiver, Klacik graduated with a bachelor's degree in sports/fitness management from LHU in 1988. He led the Bald Eagles in receiving yards in each of his four seasons.

The game:

The Bald Eagles finally come back home to host the Vulcans of California in a PSAC West showdown.

Last week saw LHU on the road for the fourth straight week and road life got the best of them in a 70-19 defeat at the hands of Edinboro. Previously the Bald Eagles fell to VMI, East Stroudsburg, Millersville, Youngstown State and Cheyney.

The Vulcans have continued to roll as they defeated IUP by a 38-12 score. California remains unbeaten on the season as they have defeated East Stroudsburg, Glenville State, Bloomsburg, Cheyney and Clarion. The Vulcans defense has played well giving up a total of 41 points across all 6 games to this point.

The series:

Lock Haven is 26-35-1 all-time against California with their last meeting coming last season as the Vulcans defeated LHU 51-7 at California.

Bald Eagles last time out:

EDINBORO, Pa. - The Lock Haven University football team (0-6, 0-1 PSAC West) fell on the road at Edinboro University (5-1, 2-0 PSAC West) 70-19 today in the Bald Eagles 2007 Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) West opener.

Junior wide receiver Damar Dowell Jr. (Buffalo, N.Y./Erie C.C.) led the Haven while pulling in two touchdown catches in the loss. Dowell scored on pass plays of 30 yards and one yard today as he made a total of eight catches for 186 yards.

The Bald Eagles found themselves trailing early, but down 21-0 Dowell pulled in the first of his two touchdowns. Dowell caught a 30-yard pass from sophomore quarterback Ilio DiPaolo (Orchard Park, N.Y./St. Francis) The extra point attempt was blocked as the Fighting Scots led 21-6.

With 8:21 left in the third quarter Dowell and DiPaolo hooked up for the second time.

This time Dowell pulled in a one yard pass from DiPaolo, cutting the Edinboro lead to 42-12 as the Haven's two-point conversion attempt failed.

Trailing 63-12 in the fourth quarter Steve Loomis (Oxford, N.Y./Oxford Academy) scored on a six-yard run.

It was the first touchdown of Loomis's career while the Dowell's two touchdowns also marked the first and second of his Bald Eagle career.

Dean Tortorice (Delmont, Pa./Franklin Regional) and Corey Gildea (Hollidaysburg, Pa./Hollidaysburg) led the Bald Eagles with seven tackles apiece. Tortorice had four solo and three assisted tackles while Gildea recorded one and six, respectively.

Darryl Robinson (Pittsburgh/McKeesport) and Shawn Crebs (Lewisburg, Pa./Lewisburg) both had six tackles.

The Bald Eagles are back in action on Saturday, Oct. 12 at 2 p.m. when they return home to take on No. 11 California (Pa.) University in PSAC West action. The game will be televised statewide by SPORTSfever television.

Vulcans last time out:

INDIANA, Pa.-California University defense controlled host Indiana through three quarters in Saturday's PSAC West football showdown between a pair of nationally-ranked teams.

In the fourth quarter, Soph. DB Terrence Johnson (Braddock, Pa./Woodland Hills) and the Vulcan defense took charge of the game as the 11th-ranked Vulcans (6-0, 2-0 PSAC West) pulled away for a 38-12 victory over the 18th-ranked Crimson Hawks (4-1, 1-1 PSAC West).

Johnson, who shared the lead in the PSAC with five interceptions last year, intercepted a pair of IUP passes in the first two minutes of the fourth quarter as the Vulcans held a 10-6 lead. It was the second-straight year Johnson had two interceptions vs. IUP.

The first interception was returned to the IUP 38-yard line, setting up a tip-toe down the sideline to paydirt by Jermaine Moye (Rochester, Pa./Rochester). Seconds later, Johnson went 47 yards down the IUP sideline for another score, extending Cal's lead to 24-6 and effectively putting the game away.

The Vulcans scored two more times in the final two minutes to give Cal its largest margin of victory in the history of the series against IUP. Cal equaled its largest point total against the Crimson Hawks, set in 2005 when the Vulcans upended IUP by a 38-23 margin. Cal's defense was the story, returning two of IUP's four turnovers for touchdowns and setting up Vulcan TDs after the other two set up a first-quarter field goal by Soph. Tyler Lorenz (Savannah, Tenn./Savannah) and Moye's fourth-quarter TD.

Sr. LB Brian Mohr (Beaver Falls, Pa./Riverside) and Jr. DB Juan Butler (McKeesport, Pa./McKeesport) each had seven tackles, including one in the IUP backfield.

Offensively, the Vulcans were led by Sr. QB Joe Ruggiero (Detroit, Mich./Franklin), who completed 11 of 18 passes for 140 yards and three touchdowns. Ruggiero, who also gained 39 yards on eight rushes, hit Sr. WR Nate Forse for a 23-yard second-quarter TD strike in the second quarter, giving Cal a 10-6 halftime lead, and an insurance score with 1:30 left in the game on a fourth-and-four at the IUP 31-yard line.

The rushing game was led by Brandon Lombardy (Moureland Hills, Pa./Chagrin Falls), who had 88 yards on 26 tries, a career low total as a starter.

The Vulcans return to action Oct. 13 with a PSAC West trip to Lock Haven. The 2 p.m. kickoff will mark Cal's third-straight week as the featured game on SPORTSfever TV.

The Last Meeting: CUP at LHU

California 51 - LHU 7

Sept. 30, 2006

CALIFORNIA, Pa. - The California University squad could do no wrong, and Lock Haven University could do little right, as the Vulcans dropped LHU 51-7 Saturday night (Sept. 30) at Hepner-Bailey Field.

The Bald Eagles did win the battle through the air, out-passing Cal U 174-111, and even won the second quarter 7-0. The true dagger came in the first four touches by the Vulcans, all resulting in touchdowns.

Cal U's Brandon Lombardy punched the first two scores in, including an 89-yard sprint for the 14-0 lead. A rushing touchdown, a passing touchdown and a pair of defensive scores gave the Vulcans a 37-0 lead at the end of one.

LHU broke into the scoring column in its second drive of the second quarter, capping an 11-play 63-yard stretch with senior wideout Andrew Briener's (Hummelstown, Pa./Hershey) first career touchdown catch, a seven-yard touch pass from freshman signal-caller Ilio DiPaolo (Athol Springs, N.Y./St. Francis). DiPaolo was 3-of-5 passing on the drive, aided by a pair of late-hit penalties called on Cal U.

Freshman Kyle Crane (McKeesport, Pa./McKeesport) picked off his first career pass on the next play from scrimmage, beginning another drive into Vulcan territory, but the Bald Eagles would stall on a fourth down inside the Cal U 25.

The Bald Eagles tightened the defensive reigns in the second half, allowing just a touchdown each in the third and fourth quarters, and disrupting any attempts Cal U quarterback Matt Humbert would have to pass. Junior safety David Show (Mill Run, Pa./Connellsville) picked off Humbert mid-way through the third, while Crane grabbed his second pass of the game on the first possession of the fourth quarter.

The Vulcans' Josh Kemp attributed for the final two Cal U scores, returning a DiPaolo interception for 50 yards and scrambling with a Chelstan Anderson II (Halifax, Pa./Halifax) fumble for a 24-yard TD.

The run game was all but shut down for LHU, as Anderson led the squad at 14 carries for 12 yards. DiPaolo, forced to pass early and often, finished 21-of-37 for 174 yards, one touchdown and three interceptions. He hit seven different players with passes, including team-leader Adam Lawrence (Hanover, Pa./Delone Catholic/Shippensburg University) seven times for 80 yards.

The defense was led by freshman Shane Barie (Export, Pa./Franklin) at four tackles, while senior linebacker Derek Harsch (Wellsboro, Pa./Wellsboro) followed with three, including one for loss. Sophomore defensive end Ali Malone (Springfield, Va./Hayfield) led the D-Line with three stops.

The WBEP plans to air the games initially on tape-delay.
