Bringing with him 17 years of Division I and I-AA coaching experience, **John Klacik** enters his third season at the helm of the Bald Eagle football program.

With two full recruiting classes under his belt, Klacik now looks to turn the page, as the Bald Eagles are looking to take the next step under his guidance. LHU will return plenty of

the experience, with 17 starters and a strong recruiting class.

After going 2-9 each of his first two seasons at the helm of the Bald Eagles Klacik is looing for the team to take a huge step forward.

Klacik, an LHU alum has spent all but one season of his coaching career at Youngstown State University, and was a part of four NCAA I-AA National Championship teams. He started with the Penguins as tight ends coach, working his way up the ladder through the offense, moving to wide receivers, quarterbacks, offensive line and then as offensive coordinator for the last four seasons. Klacik worked under current Ohio State University head coach Jim Tressel for 12 years.

A standout wide receiver, Klacik graduated with a bachelor's degree in sports/fitness management from LHU in 1988. He led the Bald Eagles in receiving yards in each of his four seasons.

Slippery Rock comes into the contest off a loss as well as they fell on Saturday to California by a 22-13 score.

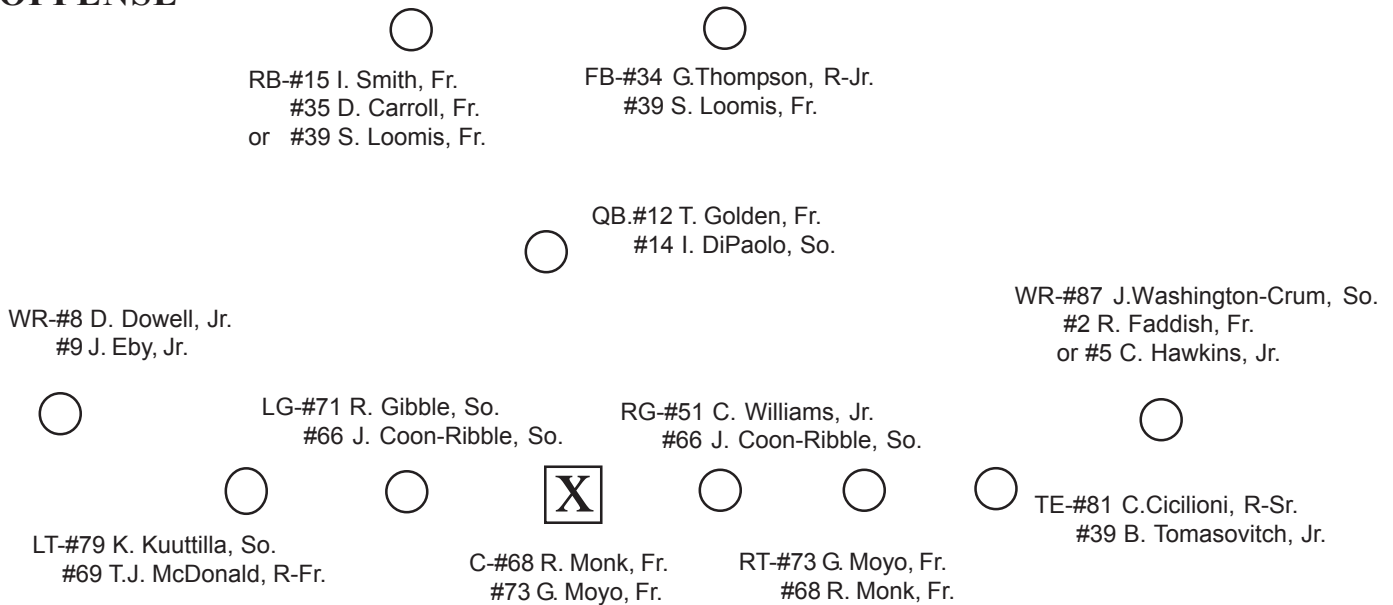
HavenSports Radio will cover the game with pregame starting at 5:00 and the opening kick slated for 5:30

The game is LHU's home season finale.

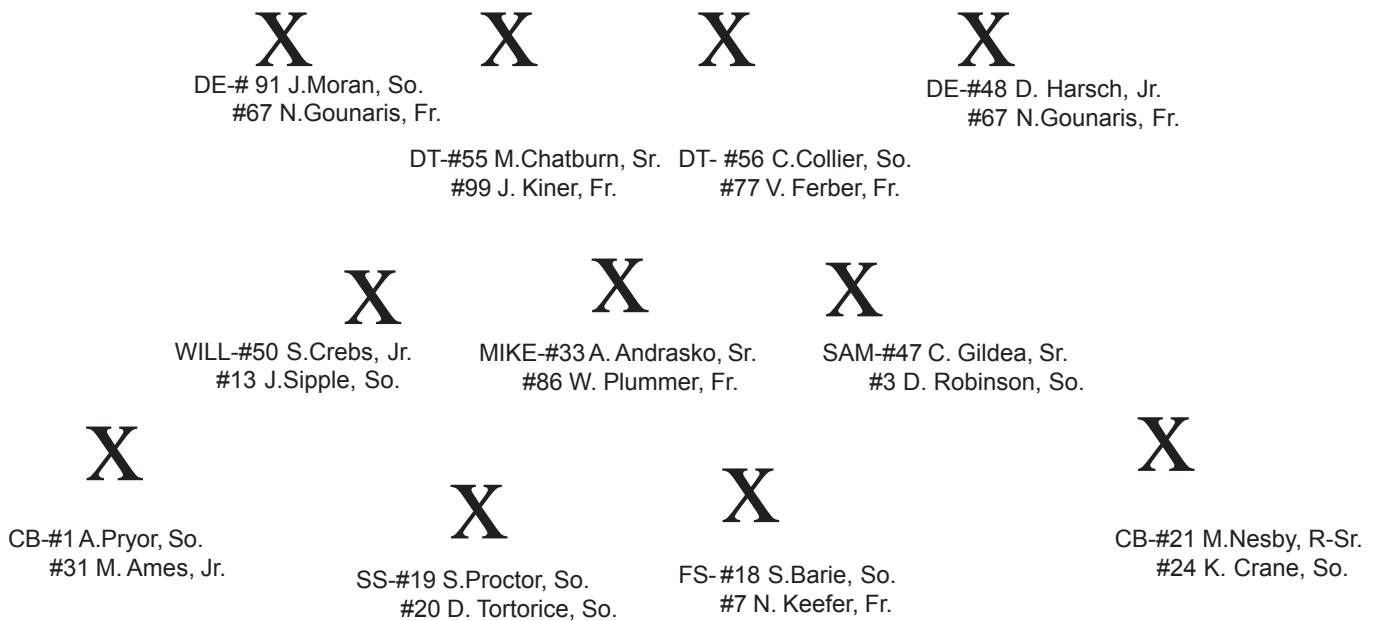

The series:

Lock Haven is 12-37-1 all-time against Slippery Rock with their last meeting coming last season as The Rock defeated Lock Haven 35-0 at Bob DiSpirito field on the campus of Slippery Rock.

Bald Eagles last time out:

SHIPPENSBURG, Pa. – The Lock Haven University Football team (0-9, 0-4 PSAC West) fell on the road to Shippensburg University (3-6, 2-2 PSAC West) by a 56-10 score at Seth Grove Stadium.

The loss saw Shippensburg racking up record numbers offensively as they used a balanced offensive attack to thwart the Bald Eagle's attempt to pick up their first win of the season.

Ship got the scoring started early as their first drive found the end zone three minutes into the first quarter, breaking the early deadlock to give them a 7-0 lead.

The long field ahead of them wouldn't bother the Red Raider offense as they would go 96 yards in 14 plays, to extend their lead to 14-0 following a Jamie Reder PAT.

LHU would quickly give the ball back to Shippensburg following another three and out. Ship would again drive down field to the Haven 20 yard line, but a Gabe Maiocco pass would be intercepted by junior linebacker Shawn Crebs (Lewisburg, Pa./Lewistown) and he would return it 70 yards to the Shippensburg one.

Following an offside penalty, freshman running back Ibrahim Smith (New Bloomfield, Pa./West Perry) would barrel into the end zone from six yards out to get LHU on the board and cut the Red Raider lead in half at 14-7.

The first frame would end that way but Ship would be ready to tack on more points in the second quarter. With 8:55 left in the second quarter, fullback Dave Wilkerson would rumble 16 yards and cross the plane of the end zone to build a 21-7 lead.

Lock Haven would fail to move the ball again on their following two drives and would give the Red Raider offense the ball back with 5:11 left in the first half.

It would only take Shippensburg 1:33 to score as Maiocco would hit Kyle Fogarty on a 75 yard pattern to extend their lead to 21 over the Bald Eagles at 28-7.

The ensuing kickoff was returned 72 yards by Segun Mallard (Brooklyn, N.Y./Carson Long Military Institute) to the Red Raider nine, and three plays later kicker Marc Domonkos (Windber, Pa./Bishop McCort) would kick a 30 yard field goal through the up rights to cut the lead to 28-10.

The Red Raiders wouldn't have the ball for long as they went 90 yards in 64 seconds to extend their lead to a comfortable 35-10, as the drive was capped off by a 42 yard scamper by fullback Aaron Dykes.

Following another pair of three and outs by LHU and a stalled Ship drive, Shippensburg would get the ball back and Maiocco would throw his third touchdown of the afternoon on a 78 yard slant route to Tim Devanney, to put the Red Raiders up 42-10 at the end of the third quarter.

Shippensburg would tack on two more touchdowns in the fourth quarter to finalize the scoring at 56-10.

The Red Raider offense racked up 709 total yards on the afternoon, which set a new school record. LHU's offense was shutout in the second half for the seventh time this season.

Leading the LHU ground attack was Smith who ran the ball six times for 17 yards.

Through the air LHU was led by sophomore quarterback Ilio DiPaolo (Orchard Park, N.Y./St. Francis), who in two quarters of work was 8-16 for 78 yards and an interception.

Leading the receiving core was junior DeMar Dowell (Buffalo, N.Y./Erie Community College) with three catches for 31 yards.

Defensively LHU was led by a 12 tackle performance by senior linebacker Corey Gildea (Hollidaysburg, Pa./Hollidaysburg)

The Bald Eagles will next be back in action on Thursday November 1, 2007 at home in their home finale against Slippery Rock. Kickoff is slated for 5:30 at Hubert Jack Stadium.

Red Raiders last time out:

SLIPPERY ROCK, PA. - Joe Ruggiero passed for 199 yards and one touchdown Saturday afternoon to lead California U. (Pa.) to a 22-13 win over The Rock in a battle of nationally ranked NCAA Division II Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference-Western Division teams on Bob DiSpirito Field at N. Kerr Thompson Stadium.

The Rock outgained California by a 347-300 margin in total offense behind a 209-yard rushing attack.

Corey Manfull led The Rock with 175 yards on 37 carries and scored one TD. Quarterback Nate Crookshank was 11 of 25 passing for 138 yards and one TD (31 yards to Paul Favers) with two interceptions. Terry Grossetti caught five passes for 49 yards.

Ruggiero completed 15 of 24 pass attempts with one TD and had one pass picked off. Nate Forse caught three passes for 71 yards, including a 39-yard TD toss from Ruggiero.

Brandon Lombardy rushed for 65 yards on 16 carries and scored two TDs before leaving the game midway through the second period with an injury.

California moved 62 yards in eight plays on the opening possession of the game to take a 6-0 lead at the 11:09 mark of the first period. Lombardy capped the drive with a two-yard burst but Tyler Lorenz's extra-point kick sailed wide right.

Lombardy scored his second TD on a one-yard run with 4:32, three plays after Darren Burns intercepted a Crookshank pass and returned it to The Rock 6 on SRU's second possession of the game. The Vulcans held a 12-0 lead after a two-point conversion pass failed.

The Vulcans' Juan Butler blocked a punt on The Rock's next possession, but the guests were unable to capitalize on the turnover as a 48-yard field goal attempt by Lorenz early in the second period fell short of the crossbar.

The Rock turned around and marched 69 yards in six plays, keyed by a 40-yard run by Manfull - who ran the ball on all six plays and capped the drive with an eight-yard run. C.J. Bahr's extra-point kick trimmed the California lead to 12-7 with 12:30 left in the first half.

The Vulcans took a 15-7 lead with 5:36 left in the half on a 21-yard field by Lorenz that was set up by a shanked, 19-yard punt that gave the guests possession at the SRU 24.

The Rock came right back to mount potential scoring drives on its two possessions but came up empty on both occasions. The first drive ended when Crookshank was intercepted by Brian Mohr at the Vulcans' 18. The last drive of the half ended at the Vulcans' 5 when time expired.

After a scoreless third period, SRU drove 84 yards in 14 plays midway through the fourth quarter to close the gap to two, 15-13. Crookshank connected with Favers for a 31-yard TD to cap the drive. SRU went for the two-point conversion to tie the score, but the pass fell incomplete.

California responded with a six-play, 68-yard drive of its own to push the margin to its final 22-13 standing with three minutes left to play.

The Rock travels to Lock Haven for a PSAC-West game Thursday, while California is at West Chester for a PSAC interdivisional game next Saturday that will pit the No. 1 and 2 teams in the NCAA Northeast Region poll in a head-to-head meeting.

The Rock is ranked seventh in the regional poll.

"This partnership enabled the launch of this initiative that will further enhance the exposure of the high-caliber of athletic competition offered by the PSAC. With commercial television station affiliates in all six Pennsylvania DMAs, the APSCUF College Football Game of the Week featuring the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference will be available to more than 4.5 million households, far exceeding the number of households of a cable-only network," said Blain.

SPORTSfever Television Network has affiliates which will air the "APSCUF College Football Game of the Week featuring the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference" include WTVE (Philadelphia-Lehigh Valley), WHP My 21-2/WLYH (Harrisburg-Lancaster-York), WQMY/WSWB (Wilkes-Barre/Scranton), WSCW (State College-Altoona-Johnstown), WIUP (Indiana County), WBGW (Pittsburgh) and WBEP (Erie). The WBEP plans to air the games initially on tape-delay.

"We look forward to be able to offer the PSAC games to the viewers of Northeast and Central Pennsylvania for the first time," said Jon Cadman, general manager of WQMY in Wilkes-Barre/Scranton.
