Bringing with him 17 years of Division I and I-AA coaching experience, **John Klacik** was named Lock Haven University head football coach, university administration announced March 8. Klacik served most recently as offensive coordinator/offensive line coach at Youngstown State University.

Klacik, an LHU alum, has spent all but one season of his coaching career at YSU, and was a part of four NCAA I-AA National Championship teams. He started with the Penguins as tight ends coach, working his way up the ladder through the offense, moving to wide receivers, quarterbacks, offensive line and then as offensive coordinator for the last four seasons. Klacik worked under current Ohio State University head coach Jim Tressel for 12 years.

He also spent the 2000 season at Division I Wake Forest University, working with the quarterbacks before returning to YSU in his most recent role.

A standout wide receiver, Klacik graduated with a bachelors degree in sports/fitness management from LHU in 1988. He led the Bald Eagles in receiving yards in each of his four seasons at the Haven, ranking eighth in school history with 1,976 career yards.

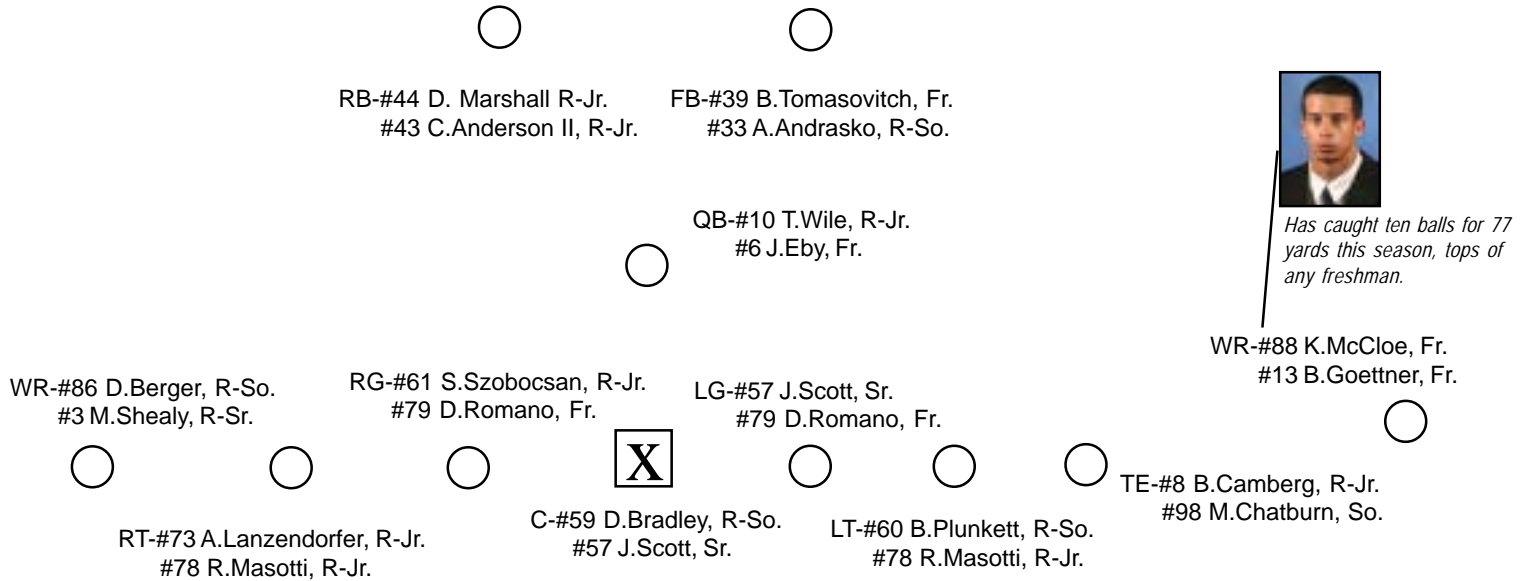
The Series

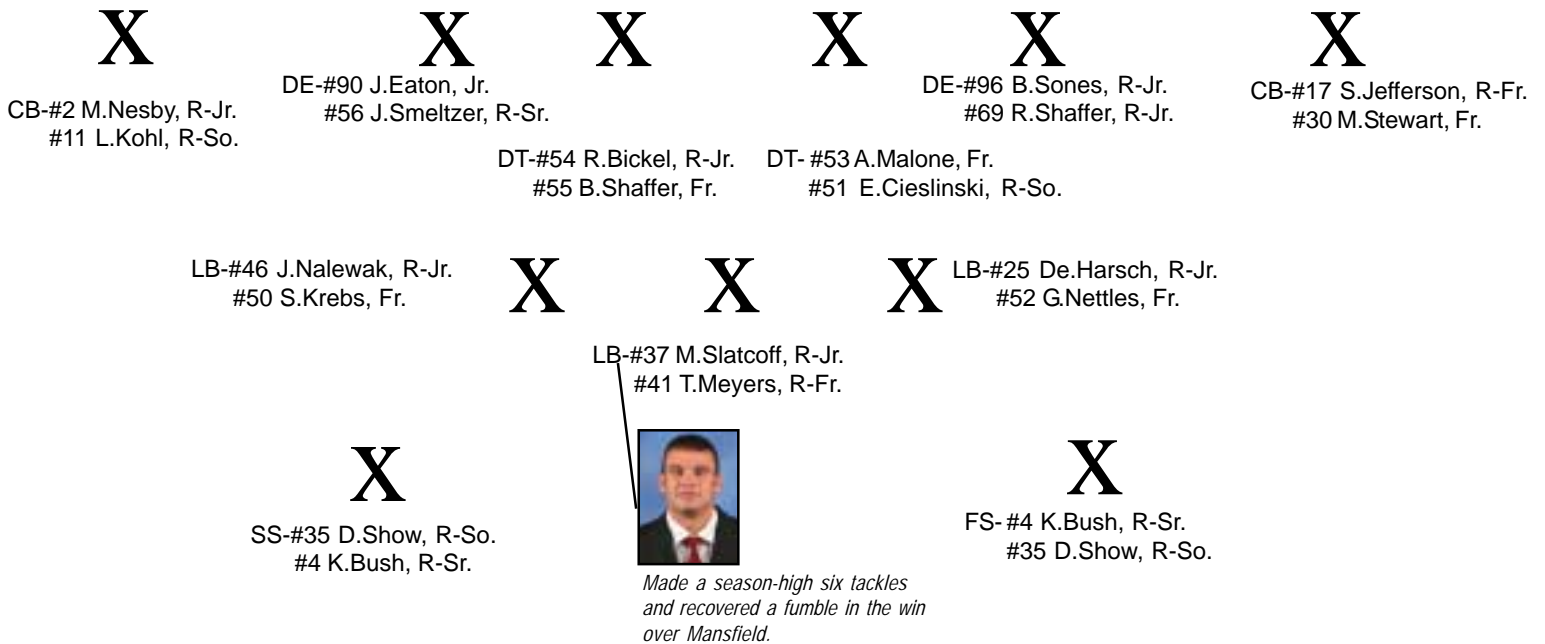
BALD EAGLE DEPTH CHART

Eagles last beat the Cal U in 2002, and last took a contest at Adamson Stadium in 1996.

Scouting the Vulcans

Cal U topped Cheyney University 49-3 a week ago, getting four touchdowns from tailback Antoine Bagwell. Bagwell is second in the PSAC and eighth in the nation, averaging 148.9 yards per game.

The Vulcan passing game is not exactly sluggish either, as quarterback Joe Ruggerio ranks second in the conference and 22nd in the nation in passing efficiency. His top two targets have been Nate Forse (32 rec., 440 yds., 1 TD) and Marcellus Garner (30 rec., 357 yds, 3 TD).

Freshmen linebacker Lloyd Price leads the way with 90 tackles, including 12 TFL, and has nabbed three turnovers with an interception and two fumble recoveries. Jared Dumm leads the team and is second in the PSAC with five interceptions.

California Head Coach John Luckhardt

John Luckhardt was named the head football coach at California University of Pa. prior to the 2002 season after a most successful tenure as the Head Football Coach and Athletic Director at nearby Washington and Jefferson College. Luckhardt brings a wealth of experience to Cal U. In addition to coaching, he has administrative skills as well as fundraising experience.

In three seasons, Luckhardt has guided the Vulcans to a 16-16 record, including a pair of six-win campaigns, the highwater mark for the program in the last two decades. His career record in 20 seasons as a head coach is 153-53-2 (74.0%).

In 17 seasons at W&J, "Lucky" compiled a 137-37-2 cumulative record and had an 83% graduation rate. His Prexies won 13 President's Athletic Conference (PAC) Championships, five NCAA Division III regional championships, made 11 appearances in the NCAA playoffs, including two national championship game showings. In addition to coaching at W&J and serving as AD from 1986 through 1998, he also served as Director of Special Projects from 1998-2000.

Last Time out for the Vulcans

California Sr. RB Antoine Bagwell (Lansing, Mich./East Lansing) rushed for 163 yards and four touchdowns, all in the first half, to lead the Vulcans (6-2), ranked 12th in the NCAA Northeast Region, to a 49-3 non-league football victory over Cheyney (2-7) Saturday.

It was Cal's 11th-straight win against Cheyney, dating back to 1973, and gave the Vulcans six victories for the third time in four seasons under head coach John Luckhardt. Cal hadn't registered six wins three times in a four-year span since the 1984-87 seasons.

It was also Cal's fourth-straight win at Adamson Stadium and sent Cheyney to its sixth-straight loss this season and sixth-straight setback at Adamson Stadium.

Ten unanswered fourth-quarter points were nearly enough for a divisional win, but Lock Haven lost to IUP (4-4, 3-1 PSAC West) 28-23 Oct. 22 at Hubert



Last time against Cal U...

LOCK HAVEN, Pa. – Down by 23 points at the end of the first quarter, the Lock Haven University football team (3-7, 1-4 PSAC West) wouldn't go down without a fight on Senior Day, taking the final three periods from California University (Pa.) (6-3, 2-3 PSAC West) 24-22 today in the 45-24 loss at Hubert Jack Stadium. Sophomore wideout **Adam Lawrence (Hanover, Pa./Delone Catholic)** hauled in six passes for a career-best 103 yards and a touchdown.

Senior quarterback **Tim Storino** balanced three interceptions with three touchdowns—all in the second half—and 267 yards, his second-best output of the year. Four different receivers made catches of over 24 yards, including a 38-yard touchdown catch by **Kellen Bush (Pittsburgh/Penn Hills)**.

The dubious start began on the Haven's first possession, after three unsuccessful plays, LHU lined up for a punt. After the snap went over **Dan Hagerman's (Scottsdale, Pa./Southmoreland)** head, he kicked it out of the back of the end zone to prevent a sure touchdown for the Vulcans.

Cal U took the ensuing safety kickoff 57 yards in six plays, capped by a six-yard touchdown catch by Garvin Graves, set up by a 40-yard run by the PSAC's leading rusher Antoine Bagwell.

After a Storino interception, freshman Cal U quarterback Matt Humbert hit Marc Huddleston for a 31-yard score—a one-handed grab in the back of the end zone—making it 16-0. The Vulcans finished their first-quarter surge on a 17-yard dash by Bagwell.

The Bald Eagle run game nearly took things back from IUP after looking at a 28-13 deficit for the beginning of the fourth quarter. LHU out-gained IUP 227-177 on the ground. Junior **Derek Marshall (Luthersburg, Pa./DuBois)** picked up 143 for the Bald Eagles.

“Our team got back in this game because they kept playing hard,” said LHU head coach **John Klacik**. “The guys didn’t get down, kept fighting and never gave up. Because of that effort, we got right back in it.”

Down 28-23 with 5:30 left and faced with a third-and-one situation for IUP on the LHU 48-yard line, Morgan was unable to gain any ground, shoved out of bounds by cornerback **Melvin Stewart (Tannersville, Pa./Pius X)** and IUP was forced to punt.

The Bald Eagles picked up one first down, and then it came to a fourth-and-three on the LHU 31. Junior quarterback **Troy Wile, Jr. (Fayetteville, Pa./Chambersburg)** who had been dangerous with his feet all day long, picking up 22 yards, got his feet crossed up with one of his lineman’s and he fell to the turf for a four-yard loss.

IUP got the scoring started on their second possession with a 29-yard dash from Morgan, set up by a pair of passes from Andrew Krewatch to Cameron Mobley.

LHU answered later on in the first, as junior **Chelstan C. Anderson II (Halifax, Pa./Halifax)** finished off a nine-play 81-yard drive with a nine-yard TD rush. Anderson carried the ball on six of the nine plays.

Junior **Jonathan Nalewak (Shamokin, Pa./Shamokin)** led all LHU tacklers with seven stops, with fellow linebacker **Derek Harsch (Wellsboro, Pa./Wellsboro Area)** adding six tackles and a fumble forced. Junior **Mike Nesby (Rankin, Pa./Woodland Hills)** added three tackles from his cornerback spot and classmate **Brad Sones (Elysburg, Pa./Southern Columbia)** made a quartet of stops with a pair for loss.

career, good for second place in the LHU record books, just two off the pace set by **Matt Mapes (2000)**.

~ Hagerman made two PATs in the loss, giving him 40 in his career, good for sixth on the list. **Dan Guers (1948)** stands next on the list at 41, while the all-time leader is **Charles Traber (1986)** at 71.

~ Junior wideout **Rafael Smith (Pittsburgh/Woodland Hills)** has 11 career touchdown catches, putting him 10th after just two years as a Bald Eagle. Three receivers (**Jeremy Burkett (1998)**, **Jon Spinosa (1995)** and **Tommy Allen (1972)**) are all poised at 12 TD grabs, while **Marcus Burkley (2003)** leads the list with 19.

~ **John Kaluzny’s** 233 rushing yards against Mansfield were the fourth-most in school history and the tops for a Bald Eagle freshman.

CHEYNEY, Pa. – Junior tailback **Derek Marshall (Luthersburg, Pa./DuBois)** has not attempted a pass in his three years at Lock Haven University, until today (Aug. 27). Marshall threw his first pass in the most crucial of situations—down six with less than two minutes left – hitting sophomore wideout **Adam Lawrence (Hanover, Pa./Shippensburg University)** in the end zone for the 17-16 win at Cheyney University.

First-year head coach **John Klacik**'s first game was defensive-minded in the first half, coming to a close at a scoreless tie. Both teams had managed just 162 total yards by halftime, punting a total of 11 times in the first two quarters.

“The thing that stuck out to our staff was that the team didn’t quit,” said Klacik. “It was a back-and-forth game, especially in the fourth quarter, and there were times when things weren’t going our way. But our kids never gave up.”

The Bald Eagles had two scoring opportunities dashed in the second quarter, ended by a fumble and a missed field goal try. Junior kicker **Dan Hagerman (Scottdale, Pa./Southmoreland)** redeemed himself by breaking the 0-0 game just shy of 40 minutes in with a 43-yard blast for the 3-0 lead.

After the Bald Eagle defense held the Wolves to a punt, a second fumble gave Cheyney the ball at the Lock Haven 31. Three plays later, Cheyney’s John Riley tied the score again with a 46-yard kick.

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Faced with the daunting task of being the Division I-AA National Champions' opening opponent, the Lock Haven University football squad (1-1) lost to James Madison University (1-0) tonight (Sept. 3) 56-0.

Falling victim to the big play, the Bald Eagles controlled the first and third quarters, surrounded by some breakdowns in both the second and fourth frames.

"I knew it would be a tough task to come in here, playing the defending champs at their home site," said LHU head coach **John Klacik**. "Our main goal was to be a better football team when we left this building tonight, and I'm proud of our guys that we accomplished that."

LHU caught the champs napping off the bat, recovering a surprise on-side kick for the first possession of the contest. The Bald Eagles were unable to do anything with that possession, but the Dukes would take the punt and march down the field on a nine-play, 82-yard touchdown drive to go up 7-0.

LHU would take over for the rest of the first quarter, getting plenty of yardage on the ground and a couple of completed passes as their best drive would stall at the JMU 37-yardline. Freshman **Jason Eby (Ulster, Pa./Athens)** looked poised in the first start of his career, completing four passes during the first quarter.

TOWSON, Md. – Lock Haven University football head coach **John Klacik**'s opening comment at the post-game press conference said it all for tonight's (Sept. 10) game.

"I'm glad we don't play another Division I-AA team next week," he said.

The last two weeks have been tough on the Bald Eagle squad (1-2) capped by a 70-0 loss at the hands of Towson University (2-0) tonight. Forced to play without their top two quarterbacks and their top two wide receivers, LHU mounted little offense, repeatedly forcing the Bald Eagle defense into tough spots.

The contest started out with some promise. After an interception on the first series for LHU resulted in a seven-yard rushing touchdown for Towson, the Bald Eagles were forced to punt.

On that Tiger possession, sophomore **David Show (Mill Run, Pa./Connellsville)** blitzed the TU quarterback, Sean Schaefer, popping the ball loose. Junior **Ryan Shaffer (DuBois, Pa./DuBois Area)** snatched the ball from mid-air, rumbling his way to the 12-yard line, a 23-yard interception return for the defensive tackle.

The next three plays set up for a 27-yard field goal, missing wide left. That was LHU's best scoring opportunity of the game, as they would fall victim to the strong Towson run game to the tune of a three-touchdown, 134-yard first quarter and a 21-0 deficit.

LOCK HAVEN, Pa. – Power Off-Tackle. Out of the 74 run plays the Lock Haven University football squad (2-4, 0-1 PSAC West) had in their 24-12 win over Mansfield University (0-5, 0-1 PSAC East) today (Oct. 1), 61 were the power off-tackle.

“When your offensive line plays as tough as they did today,” said LHU head coach **John Klacik**, “the backs have room to run and that transfers to a win.”

The Mountaineers knew it was coming but couldn't do anything about it. Freshman **John Kaluzny (Mill Hall, Pa./Central Mountain)**, carrying the ball for just the second game this season, managed an impressive 39-carry 233-yard performance for the Bald Eagles, seconded by junior **Chelstan C. Anderson II's (Halifax, Pa./Halifax)** 145 yards and two touchdowns. As a team, the Bald Eagles rushed for 434 yards on 71 carries. Kaluzny's effort ranks fourth in LHU's single game record book.

A local star for the Central Mountain High School squad, Kaluzny had a few extra fans in the Homecoming crowd today.

“I had a lot of friends and family in the stands,” he said. “and that really gave me a lift.”

LOCK HAVEN, Pa. – On a cold day giving Bald Eagle fans a preview of weather to come, key penalties and turnovers kept the Lock Haven University football team (2-5, 0-2 PSAC West) from getting their first conference victory today (Oct. 8) in a 26-7 loss to Shippensburg University (3-4, 1-2 PSAC West) at Hubert Jack Stadium.

The Raiders specialize in the Wing-T offense, a three running-back set that attempts to confuse with motion and relies on big rushing numbers. While the Bald Eagles were down 17-0 at the half, it had nothing to do with the powerful run game of Shippensburg.

“I thought our defense played the run real well today, the best I've seen anyone stop Ship this season,” said LHU head coach **John Klacik**. “They only had 26 rushing yards at the half. It was the pass defense that I was unhappy with at times.”
