Bringing with him 17 years of Division I and I-AA coaching experience, **John Klacik** was named Lock Haven University head football coach, university administration announced March 8. Klacik served most recently as offensive coordinator/offensive line coach at Youngstown State University.

Klacik, an LHU alum, has spent all but one season of his coaching career at YSU, and was a part of four NCAA I-AA National Championship teams. He started with the Penguins as tight ends coach, working his way up the ladder through the offense, moving to wide receivers, quarterbacks, offensive line and then as offensive coordinator for the last four seasons. Klacik worked under current Ohio State University head coach Jim Tressel for 12 years.

He also spent the 2000 season at Division I Wake Forest University, working with the quarterbacks before returning to YSU in his most recent role.

A standout wide receiver, Klacik graduated with a bachelors degree in sports/fitness management from LHU in 1988. He led the Bald Eagles in receiving yards in each of his four seasons at the Haven, ranking eighth in school history with 1,976 career yards.

## The Series

Cal U has a 32-14-1 all-time advantage in the series, with the Fighting Scots taking a 38-17 victory last season. The Bald Eagles last beat Edinboro in 2000, a 20-16 tally at Hubert Jack Stadium.

## Scouting the Scots

Edinboro comes into Saturday's contest ranked No. 24 in the most recent D2Football.com poll and has had it's way with the PSAC West so far this season. The Scots are tied with California (Pa.) for the divisional lead at 5-1, and the lone Edinboro loss has come at the hands of Cal U.

Defense powers the victories for Edinboro, as the Scots are ranked first in the PSAC in overall and rush defense, and fourth in passing defense. Line-backer Ben Stroup leads the team in total tackles with 71, including 15 for loss and five sacks. Defensive back Chris Avery leads the conference in interceptions with six.

The offense is a balanced attack, led by a pair of running backs in Ulysee Davis and Kelvin Collins who rank eighth and ninth in the PSAC in rushing per game. Justin Bouch has added 1,265 yards through the air, with 13 touchdowns and seven interceptions. Bouch's main target is Ryan Valasek, good for 21 catches, 359 yards and four scores.

## Edinboro Head Coach Lou Tepper

Veteran Division I mentor Lou Tepper was appointed the 12th head football coach at Edinboro University, officially taking charge of the Fighting Scot program on January 5, 2000. He promised a tough and classy program, and in four short years delivered a championship team that fans and alumni enthusiastically endorse.

Tepper inherited an Edinboro program which had won just eleven games in the previous three seasons. The Scots have shown consistent improvement in "Coach Tep's" five years, culminated by consecutive PSAC championships for the first time in Edinboro history, the best two-year record in Edinboro history, and the only PSAC team chosen for the NCAA Division II playoffs each of the past two seasons.

Each phase of Edinboro football has made a dramatic turn upward. The offense has averaged over 30 points and nearly 400 yards each the past two seasons, with tremendous balance between rushing and passing. The defense led the nation with 42 turnovers and 30 interceptions while playing stingy run defense in 2004. Truth be known, Tepper's real passion is for special teams, despite his national reputation on defense. Edinboro has not had a kick blocked the last two years, while blocking four kicks a year ago, with two blocked punts returned for touchdowns.

## Last Time out for the Fighting Scots

Justin Bouch threw a pair of touchdown passes to Kyle Witucki and Edinboro blocked a punt and recovered it for a touchdown for the third straight week, propelling the Fighting Scots to a 33-7 win over Kutztown. Edinboro has won three straight games to move to 7-2 overall, while the Golden Bears fall to 1-8.

Edinboro entered the contest ranked seventh in the Northeast region. The victory, coupled with Bryant's 27-14 win over Bentley, kept the Fighting Scots' playoff hopes alive. Bentley was ranked sixth in the region and concluded its season today.

Bouch three both of his touchdowns in the second quarter as Edinboro snapped a scoreless tie after one period with 20 second-quarter markers. The first score was set up by a 29-yard punt return by Deonte Peters, giving Edinboro the ball at the EU 43. With Kelvin Collins doing most of the damage, the Scots drove 57 yards in 11 plays. Bouch hooked up with Witucki

Last time against Edinboro...

**EDINBORO, Pa.** – The Lock Haven football team (3-8, 1-5 PSAC West) was plagued by another slow start today, falling behind No. 24 Edinboro University (8-2, 5-1 PSAC West) 14-0 in the first quarter and eventually 38-17 at the end of the game. Sophomore quarterback **Rob Kristiniak (Flourtown, Pa./Springfield Township)** ran for two touchdowns in the losing effort.

The Fighting Scots scored on six of their seven red-zone chances during the game, including a 4-yard pass from Justin Bouch to Justin Lipscomb, breaking the scoreless tie with 11:16 in the first. Harlan Hill Trophy candidate Andre Burke tacked on the other first-period score, a two-yard rush capping a 10-play 63-yard drive.

LHU would answer in the second quarter with Kristiniak's first score, a three-yard rush. Lipscomb caught his second touchdown pass to extend the Fighting Scot lead back to two scores at the half.

Sophomore **Dan Hagerman (Scottdale, Pa./Southmoreland)** cut the lead to 21-10 in the third quarter on a 45-yard field goal, the longest of his career. Hagerman hit field goals in seven of the team's eleven games this season. Matt Phillips punched it in from one yard out, capping a marathon 14-play drive for the 'Boro.

Kristiniak struck again with 14:41 left in the fourth, this time from four yards out, finishing a drive that began in the third quarter, and bringing the game back to a manageable 28-17.

on a one-yard scoring pass at the 11:47 mark. Kody Robertson's extra point made it 7-0. Collins carried seven times for 37 yards on the drive.

**Last Time out for the Bald Eagles**

The Lock Haven football team (2-8, 0-5 PSAC West) lost their final road contest of 2005 at California University (Pa.) (7-2, 4-1 PSAC West) tonight (Oct. 29) 48-7. Junior tailback **Derek Marshall (Luthersburg, Pa./DuBois)** had his second-consecutive 100-yard rushing game, but it wasn't enough, as the Bald Eagles dropped their fourth straight.

Neither team could get going offensively in the first quarter, as LHU punted four times on four possessions, and Cal U managed a trio of drives into Lock Haven territory, but each one of them stalled.

The Bald Eagles did get one first-quarter turnover. Junior **Jonathan Nalewak's (Shamokin, Pa./Shamokin)** quarterback sack produced a fumble that **Eddie Cieslinski (Levittown, Pa./Pennsbury)** was able to recover, stopping a Vulcan drive on the LHU half of the field.

The Vulcans made up for lost time in the second quarter with three passing touchdowns, a bit of a surprise from the team that possesses the second-best running back in the conference, Antoine Bagwell.

Marshall wouldn't let the Cal U defense out of the half unscathed, as he finished off a 13-play 80-yard drive with a 24 yard touchdown rush. Cal U led at the half 21-7.

Cal U picked up where they left off in the second half with a pair of passing touchdowns from Joe Ruggerio. The sophomore signal-caller would finish with five passing TDs on the day.

Marshall was impressive for the second week in a row, averaging 5.1 yards per carry for his second trip to the 100-yard club. Junior **Troy Wile, Jr. (Fayetteville, Pa./Chambersburg)** was the team's leading passer with a 7-for-11 effort and 34 yards. Tight end **Brian Camberg (Altoona, Pa./Altoona Area)** led the LHU receivers with a four-catch 25-yard night.

On the defensive side, a total team effort evidenced by the six within one tackle of the team lead. Sophomore

**David Show (Mill Run, Pa./Connellsville)** led the LHU effort with four.

**Breakin' Records**

~ Junior kicker **Dan Hagerman** booted three field goals in the 28-23 loss to IUP, giving him 22 three-pointers in his career, good for second place in the LHU record books, just two off the pace set by **Matt Mapes (2000)**.

~ Hagerman made a PAT in the loss to Cal U, giving him 41 in his career, good for a tie with **Dan Guers (1948)** for fifth, while the all-time leader is **Charles Traber (1986)** at 71.

~ Junior wideout **Rafael Smith (Pittsburgh/Woodland Hills)** has 11 career touchdown catches, putting him 10th after just two years as a Bald Eagle. Three receivers (**Jeremy Burkett (1998)**, **Jon Spinosa (1995)** and **Tommy Allen (1972)**) are all poised at 12 TD grabs, while **Marcus Burkley (2003)** leads the list with 19.

**DO YOU CARE?**

When Derek Marshall ran for 132 yards against Cal U, it marked the first time a Bald Eagle had run for 100+ in consecutive games since Maurice Walker did it a year ago.

Marshall threw his first pass in the most crucial of situations—down six with less than two minutes left – hitting sophomore wideout **Adam Lawrence (Hanover, Pa./Shippensburg University)** in the end zone for the 17-16 win at Cheyney University.

First-year head coach **John Klacik**'s first game was defensive-minded in the first half, coming to a close at a scoreless tie. Both teams had managed just 162 total yards by halftime, punting a total of 11 times in the first two quarters.

## 2005 BALD EAGLE FOOTBALL

**HARRISONBURG, Va.** – Faced with the daunting task of being the Division I-AA National Champions' opening opponent, the Lock Haven University football squad (1-1) lost to James Madison University (1-0) tonight (Sept. 3) 56-0.

Falling victim to the big play, the Bald Eagles controlled the first and third quarters, surrounded by some breakdowns in both the second and fourth frames.

"I knew it would be a tough task to come in here, playing the defending champs at their home site," said LHU head coach **John Klacik**. "Our main goal was to be a better football team when we left this building tonight, and I'm proud of our guys that we accomplished that."

LHU caught the champs napping off the bat, recovering a surprise on-side kick for the first possession of the contest. The Bald Eagles were unable to do anything with that possession, but the Dukes would take the punt and march down the field on a nine-play, 82-yard touchdown drive to go up 7-0.

LHU would take over for the rest of the first quarter, getting plenty of yardage on the ground and a couple of completed passes as their best drive would stall at the JMU 37-yardline. Freshman **Jason Eby (Ulster, Pa./Athens)** looked poised in the first start of his career, completing four passes during the first quarter.

**TOWSON, Md.** – Lock Haven University football head coach **John Klacik**'s opening comment at the post-game press conference said it all for tonight's (Sept. 10) game.

"I'm glad we don't play another Division I-AA team next week," he said.

The last two weeks have been tough on the Bald Eagle squad (1-2) capped by a 70-0 loss at the hands of Towson University (2-0) tonight. Forced to play without their top two quarterbacks and their top two wide receivers, LHU mounted little offense, repeatedly forcing the Bald Eagle defense into tough spots.

The contest started out with some promise. After an interception on the first series for LHU resulted in a seven-yard rushing touchdown for Towson, the Bald Eagles were forced to punt.

On that Tiger possession, sophomore **David Show (Mill Run, Pa./Connellsville)** blitzed the TU quarterback, Sean Schaefer, popping the ball loose. Junior **Ryan Shaffer (DuBois, Pa./DuBois Area)** snatched the ball from mid-air, rumbling his way to the 12-yard line, a 23-yard interception return for the defensive tackle.

The next three plays set up for a 27-yard field goal, missing wide left. That was LHU's best scoring opportunity of the game, as they would fall victim to the strong Towson run game to the tune of a three-touchdown, 134-yard first quarter and a 21-0 deficit.
