Prior to his appointment at Lock Haven, Moore was the Chief Executive Officer and founder of the Singapore Professional Football League. He served as the National Coach of Singapore, leading the team to unprecedented success including the national team's first ever Malaysia Cup and League 'double' in 1994. His background includes stints as the head coach of the Al Jahra Club and Al Salmiya Clubs in Kuwait in 1986-89 and 1989-90, respectively. Moore was also a National Coach for the New Zealand F.A. from 1978 through 1986, a stint which included a trip to the World Cup in Spain in 1982, and several FIFA world age group tournaments. He also spent time coaching in Japan and Malaysia.
