**Doug Moore** enters his third season with the Lock Haven men's soccer program. He is the 12th coach of the Haven soccer program, which has built an overall record of 520-255-64 (.658 winning percentage) since its inception in 1938. In two seasons with the Bald Eagles, Moore has coached five players to All-Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference honors and two to All-Northeast Region honors.

Prior to his appointment at Lock Haven, Moore was the Chief Executive Officer and founder of the Singapore Professional Football League. He served as the national coach of Singapore, leading the team to unprecedented success including the national team's first ever Malaysia Cup victory in 1994. His background includes stints as the head coach of the Al Jahra Club and Al Samiya Club in Kuwait in 1986-89 and 1989-90, respectively. Moore was also a staff coach for the New Zealand F.A. from 1981 through 1986, a stint which included a trip to the World Cup in Spain in 1982.

He is a 1966 graduate from Sheffield Hallam University in Sheffield, England, and holds a full coaching license from the English Football Association, a FIFA diploma and the NSCAA national diploma. He has worked as a lecturer on the sport, and is the author of several soccer handbooks and other publications.

## The Game

The No. 16 Lock Haven University men's soccer team (12-4-3, 5-2-1 PSAC) meets a familiar opponent as they square-off with Millersville University (9-6-4, 5-2-1 PSAC) Wednesday, Nov. 3 at McCollum Field in a semifinal match of the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference playoffs. Ticket prices are \$7 for adults and \$2 for students.

The Bald Eagles will meet the Marauders for the second time in five days, as LHU hosted Millersville in the final game of the regular season, a 3-0 victory, on Oct. 30.

## The Series

LHU holds an impressive 23-8-2 advantage in the all-time series, including the win earlier this year. The Bald Eagles downed the Marauders 3-0 in a soggy contest at Foundation Fields to clinch the semifinal-round home game.

### Scouting IUP

Indiana University enters today's match with a 9-6-4 overall and a 5-2-1 PSAC record. The Marauders have won five of their last seven, the wins coming by a total score of 25-5.

Freshman Austin Cotrell leads the scoring attack for Millersville, notching nine goals and four assists for 22 total points, good for sixth in the PSAC. Goalkeeper Damian Ambrosia has a 1.11 goals-against average.

Head coach Bob Charles is the winningest coach in Marauder soccer history, putting together a 187-138-38 overall record in his 18 seasons.

### Last Time vs. Millersville

Freshman striker **Ashley Rosindale** (Bradford, England/Beckfoot School) tallied first half goals two minutes apart and added a second half assist on **Andrew Meehan's** (Cheltenham, Pa./Cheltenham) goal, leading No. 16 Lock Haven to a 3-0 victory over visiting Millersville in a key PSAC men's soccer match Saturday.

With the victory, Lock Haven, ranked 16th in the NSCAA Division II poll, earned home field advantage for this Wednesday's PSAC tournament semifinal contest (1 p.m.) against Millersville in a head-to-head tiebreak. The Bald Eagles improved their unbeaten string to 10 matches (8-0-2) since late September. Both the Bald Eagles and Marauders finished in a tie for second place in the PSAC regular season standings with 16 points, three behind California (19 points, 6-1-1).

Lock Haven goalkeeper **Chad Feerrar** (Lock Haven, Pa./Central Mountain) recorded four saves to improve his season mark to 9-1-1.

### Streakin'

LHU is in the midst of a ten-game streak without a loss, going 8-0-2 over that stretch. The Bald Eagles haven't lost a conference match since Sept. 25 at Kutztown University. Freshman forward **Ashley Rosindale** has had eight of his 10 goals during that 10-game stretch.

### Outlasting the Opposition

The Haven was undefeated in overtime contests this season, going 2-0-2 in extra frames. The two Bald Eagle wins were at Southhampton College and then-

No. 15 California University (Pa.). LHU hasn't lost an overtime contest since Sept. 4, 2002 at Felician College, a 3-2 decision. Since that game, the Bald Eagles are 3-0-5 in overtime games.

### Giant Killers

LHU is 2-0 in games against ranked opponents this season, taking a 4-2 decision from then-No. 25 Shippensburg University on Oct. 6, and a 3-2 double-overtime win against then-No. 15 California (Pa.) on Oct. 23. Sophomore **Andrew Meehan** scored goals in both of those contests.

### Peaking at the Right Time

The Bald Eagles enter this game ranked No. 16 in the adidas/National Soccer Coaches Association of America Division II National Rankings. LHU made the jump from No. 24 to No. 16 with the 3-2 double-overtime victory against Cal U.

### Put an 'S' on His Chest

Freshman **Ashley Rosindale** has five game-winning goals this season, meaning he has tallied a game-winner in nearly half of the team's 12 wins this year.
