Head coach **Kelley Green** enters season number six at the helm of the Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania softball team. In her five seasons, the Lady Eagles have put together a 136-107 overall mark including a record-breaking season in 2002 when Lock Haven posted a program-best 37 wins.

In 2004, the Lady Eagles had a 14-win turnaround from the previous season, working their way to a 27-17 mark, the second 20-win season under Green. The team also had a 16-4 PSAC West ledger, good for second place in the division. Four Lady Eagles earned all-conference honors.

In 2002, Green took the Lady Eagles to the NCAA Division II Mid-Atlantic Region finals, the PSAC tournament, and wrapped up the year with a school-record 37 wins. Six Lady Eagles earned All-PSAC honors and one went on to garner LHU's first-ever All-America award. Coach Green was named PSAC West Coach of the Year, and both Green and then assistant coach Leslie Moore earned the NFCA Division II Regional Coaching Staff of the Year award.

Prior to coming to Lock Haven, Green spent two seasons playing for the Virginia Roadsters, a team in the Women's Professional Softball League.

Green also served two seasons as an assistant coach for the women's softball team at Penn State University from 1996-98, where she was an integral part of the Lady Lions' success.

The Game

The No. 15 Lock Haven University softball team (32-6, 17-1 PSAC West) will travel to Shippensburg, Pa. for the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Tournament, running from April 28-30. LHU's first matchup will be Thursday, April 28 at 2 p.m. against the winner of the No. 17 Bloomsburg University (36-6, 17-5 PSAC East) and California University (Pa.) (24-14, 13-7 PSAC West) game from 10 a.m. that day.

This marks the second-straight season the Lady Eagles have made the PSAC playoffs, but the first time since 1988 that they have won the PSAC West.

Scouting the Huskies

No. 17 Bloomsburg University boasts a team ERA of 0.98 with four pitchers having seen starts. Amanda Smith leads the team in victories with a 12-3 record and a 1.35 ERA.

At the plate, the Huskies feature four .400 hitters, led by Sara Roba at .409. The senior first baseman also paces the team in home runs (8) and RBI (48).

Last Time vs. Bloomsburg

The Lock Haven University softball team's quest for the 2004 NCAA Division II Mid-Atlantic Region title came to an end in a 5-0 loss against Bloomsburg University.

In a game resumed after one and a half scoreless innings played the day before were temporarily halted by rain, the Huskies came alive in the top of the third to put two on the board for the early lead. Bloomsburg's Samantha Basalik scored off a single by Sara Roba, who in turn came home after a double by Dee Wolfe. In the top of the fourth, BU's Kelly Zarski led off with a homer over the left field fence. Roba then brought two more runs in with a bases-loaded single for the 5-0 lead.

The Haven posted three of its five hits in the bottom of the fourth, loading the bases, but was unable to capitalize.

Shona M. Guevara (Chino Hills, Calif./Humboldt State University) took the pitching loss, falling to 14-8 on the season after throwing the first three innings and giving up seven hits and four of the five runs. **Molly Shuey (Tower City, Pa./Williams Valley)** threw the final four innings, giving up only one hit while striking out four. Five different batters registered single hits for the Haven including **Lynn Spiezio (Trooper, Pa./Methacton)**, **Kristin Frantz (Boyertown, Pa./Boyertown)**, **Heather Johnson (Williamsport, Pa./Williamsport)**, **Kelly Deitrick (Danville, Pa./Danville)** and **Jocelyn Tutrani**.

Scouting the Vulcans

Cal U has perennially been a power in the PSAC West, until the Lady Eagles upended them this season, taking the division title. The Vulcans are led at the plate by Jennifer Doty, with an amazing .493 average. The junior infielder also paces the squad with five home runs and 14 RBI. Hitting is the team's forte, as they managed a .350 batting average so far this season.

In the circle, junior Becky Mezyk led the team in innings this season, going 12-7 with a 2.03 ERA.

Last Time vs. California

The sixth inning was good to the Lady Eagles April 16, as both games featured huge sixth inning comebacks for the Lock Haven softball team in wins over California University (Pa.) 5-4 and 10-7, on Senior Day at Lawrence Field. Game one gave the Lady Eagles the PSAC West crown.

In game two, all six LHU seniors peppered the starting lineup. **Molly Shuey** got her third start of the season, **Lynn Spiezio** scored a run, **Kelly Deitrick** was 1-for-6 with a run scored on the day, catcher **Janet Paterson (Frederick, Md./Walkersville)** hit a key home run and drove in four, while **Kristin Frantz** and **Colleen Welsh (Pottsville, Pa./Pottsville)** both scored runs.

The Vulcans posted the first five runs of the contest, before LHU answered back with three in the fourth. The big blow of the inning was a two-RBI double from Paterson.

Cal U made it 6-3 with another run in the sixth, before the Lady Eagle bats exploded again in the sixth. Paterson, **Danielle Fraser (West Milford, N.J./West Milford)**, **Stephanie Hallowell (Eagleville, Pa./Methacton)** and **Courtney Hughes**

Cal U managed one run in the seventh, but the rally stopped there. Junior **Jeanette Middlestead (Coatesville, Pa./La Salle University)** got the win in relief to improve to 12-1. Vulcan starter Becky Mezyk fell to 9-7 with a complete-game effort.

Lady Eagles Last Time Out

The No. 15 Lock Haven softball team finished the conference season April 26 the same way they started it—with a sweep—this time taking out Edinboro University 5-0, 3-2.

Game two was a tightly-contested affair, the Haven prevailing on the bat of **Stephanie Hallowell**. The sophomore third baseman was 2-for-4 and drove in all three Lady Eagle runs in the 3-2 win.

The Fighting Scots took the lead in their first trip to the plate, scoring a run on an error for an early 1-0 lead. Edinboro doubled their advantage on another error in the third.

After a pair of singles and a walk loaded the bases in the fifth, Hallowell doubled everyone home to get the win.
