Head coach **Kelley Green** enters season number six at the helm of the Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania softball team. In her five seasons, the Lady Eagles have put together a 137-109 overall mark including a record-breaking season in 2002 when Lock Haven posted a program-best 37 wins.

In 2004, the Lady Eagles had a 14-win turnaround from the previous season, working their way to a 27-17 mark, the second 20-win season under Green. The team also had a 16-4 PSAC West ledger, good for second place in the division. Four Lady Eagles earned all-conference honors.

In 2002, Green took the Lady Eagles to the NCAA Division II Mid-Atlantic Region finals, the PSAC tournament, and wrapped up the year with a school-record 37 wins. Six Lady Eagles earned All-PSAC honors and one went on to garner LHU's first-ever All-America award. Coach Green was named PSAC West Coach of the Year, and both Green and then assistant coach Leslie Moore earned the NFCA Division II Regional Coaching Staff of the Year award.

Prior to coming to Lock Haven, Green spent two seasons playing for the Virginia Roadsters, a team in the Women's Professional Softball League.

Green also served two seasons as an assistant coach for the women's softball team at Penn State University from 1996-98, where she was an integral part of the Lady Lions' success.

## The Game

The No. 14 Lock Haven University softball team (33-8) will make the trip once again to Shippensburg, Pa. for the NCAA Division II Mid-Atlantic Regional Tournament, running from May 12-15. LHU's first matchup will be Thursday, May 12 at 4 p.m. against the winner of the No. 18 Bloomsburg University (40-8) and Elizabeth City State University (16-10) game from noon that day.

This marks the second-straight season the Lady Eagles have made the NCAA regional playoffs, and the fourth season in school history. Three of those four (2002, 2004, 2005) have come during **Kelley Green's** six seasons as head coach.

### Scouting the Huskies

No. 17 Bloomsburg University boasts a team ERA of 1.21 with four pitchers having seen starts. Amanda Smith leads the team in victories with a 14-3 record and a 1.31 ERA.

At the plate, the Huskies feature two .400 hitters, led by Dee Wolfe at .401. Senior first baseman Sara Roba paces the team in home runs (8) and RBI (48). The Huskies are coached by 28-year skipper Jan Hutchinson.

### Last Time vs. Bloomsburg

One good inning was all it took for the No. 17 Bloomsburg Huskies to knock off the No. 15 Lock Haven softball team April 30 in the PSAC Tournament. LHU held a two-run lead going into the bottom of the sixth when the Huskies rattled off two hits cutting the advantage to one. The next batter reached on an error which was followed by a home run to left center to give Bloomsburg the 3-2 lead and eventually the win.

Lock Haven's two runs came early in the third. Senior **Colleen Welsh (Pottsville, Pa./Pottsville)** singled through the right side and then advanced to second on a sacrifice bunt by classmate **Lynn Spiezo (Trooper, Pa./Methacton)**. The first run came when sophomore **Stephanie Hallowell (Eagleville, Pa./Methacton)** doubled to left field to bring home Welsh. This was followed by a ground out to third by junior **Courtney Hughes (Schwenksville, Pa./Souderton)**. And finally the second run crossed the plate due to a double to right center by junior **Heather Johnson (Williamsport, Pa./Williamsport)**.

Junior **Jeanette Middlestead (Coatesville, Pa./La Salle University)** suffered the loss (13-3) while giving up seven hits and striking out eight. Bloomsburg's Jaime Wilson (11-2) got the win giving up only two hits in four innings of work.

### Scouting the Vikings

Elizabeth City State has the top pitcher and hitter of the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) the conference in which they won the title to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA regional.

A. Graham leads the Vikings in the circle with a 12-7 record and a 3.39 ERA. At the plate, T. Smith boasts a .528 average with four home runs and 39 RBI in just 22 games.

### Lady Eagles Last Time at NCAA Regional

The Lock Haven softball team's quest for the NCAA Division II Mid-Atlantic Region title came to an end May 8, 2004 in a 5-0 loss against Bloomsburg.

In a game resumed after one and a half scoreless innings played the day before were temporarily halted by rain, the Huskies came alive in the top of the third to put two on the board for the early lead. Bloomsburg's Samantha Basalik scored off a single by Sara Roba, who in turn came home after a double by Dee Wolfe. In the top of the fourth, BU's Kelly Zarski led off with a homer over the left field fence. Roba then brought two more runs in with a bases-loaded single for the 5-0 lead.

The Haven posted three of its five hits in the bottom of the fourth, loading the bases, but was unable to capitalize.

**Shona Guevara (Chino Hills, Calif./Humboldt State University)** took the pitching loss, falling to 14-8 on the season after throwing the first three innings and giving up seven hits and four of the five runs. **Molly Shuey (Tower City, Pa./Williams Valley)** threw the final four innings, giving up only one hit while striking out four.

books. The biggest culprit this season has been senior centerfielder **Lynn Spiezo**. The speedy leadoff hitter surpassed the marks for career at-bats and hits this season, and is setting her sights on the all-time stolen base lead as well. She took the at-bats and hits records from **Theresa Kovach** (1993), passing her marks of 468 and 191, respectively.

Spiezo now stands at 544 at-bats, with 198 hits. She also has 79 stolen bases, just one behind **Lori DiVecchio** (1991).

Junior shortstop **Courtney Hughes** has already surpassed the career home run title at LHU, smacking 14 home runs in her three-year career. Hughes had an explosion of power this season, getting eight round-trippers to put her past **Jen Horner** (1993).

The team is also four wins shy of the school record of 37 victories, set in 2002.
