A 14-year veteran of the Lock Haven University wrestling program, **Anthony "Rocky" Bonomo** begins season number three at the helm of the Bald Eagle wrestling program after assuming the reigns in the spring of 2002. An assistant coach with the LHU program since 1990, Bonomo is the ninth coach in school history, succeeding Carl Poff, head coach from 1990-2002.

Bonomo and the Bald Eagles battled through a tough schedule in 2003-04, posting a 4-10 record and a 7th-place Eastern Wrestling League finish.

He led the 2003 Bald Eagles to the program's 12th-straight winning season with a 12-11 overall record. The Haven added a runner-up finish at the PSAC championships and a fourth-place showing at the Eastern Wrestling League Tournament in addition to sending four grapplers to the NCAA Division I National Wrestling Championships. One Bald Eagle came home an All-American while the team placed 35th overall at the national tournament.

Bonomo has brought a wealth of experience and talent to Team Lock Haven, contributing to the Division I program in all phases of its operation. Among his many responsibilities, Bonomo directs the teaching, academic monitoring and fundraising efforts of the Bald Eagle squad.

### The Meet

The Lock Haven University wrestling team (5-7, 2-2 EWL) will look to improve upon its 32 individual Eastern Wrestling League (EWL) Champions in school history this weekend as they travel to Clarion, Pa. for the EWL Championships.

Grapplers from Bloomsburg University, Edinboro University, #25 West Virginia University, the University of Pittsburgh, Cleveland State University, Clarion University and Lock Haven will compete in a double elimination tournament-style format.

Broadcast for the finals will be available on WBPZ 1230 AM and a possible webcast available at [www.redzonemedia.com](http://www.redzonemedia.com). All-session tickets are \$30 for adults and \$20 for students and can be purchased at the door.

### Last Time out for LHU

The Lock Haven wrestling team got three free victories and plenty of surprise ones in taking out Clarion 37-7, in the final dual of the season at Thomas Fieldhouse. The Bald Eagles earned victories in all but two bouts on the night.

Junior **B.J. Mikeska (Derry, Pa./Bloomsburg University)**, and freshmen **Ben Hepburn (Williamsport, Pa./Loyalsock)** and

**Jamie Nagel (Shade Gap, Pa./Mount Union Area)** all earned upset wins for the Bald Eagles.

"What most impresses me is the way that Mikeska, Hepburn and Nagel won," said LHU head coach Rocky Bonomo. "Each of those victories came in the final minute. That's what we want to see, our guys working hard throughout the match to get wins."

After forfeit victories for freshman **Obe Blanc (Naples, Fla./Lely)** and junior **Jim Collins (Jonestown, Pa./Northern Lebanon)**, 141-pounder **Brian Ellis (Bethlehem, Pa./Liberty)** took on No. 10 Frank Edgar. The sophomore surprised Edgar with a takedown in the first half-minute, but Edgar rallied for a 5-4 advantage at the end of the period. Edgar would also control the rest of the match, finishing with a 17-5 major victory.

Junior **Joshua A. Medina (Las Vegas/Pima C.C.)** continues to be nothing short of dominant as of late, tonight earning the 18-9 major decision, his 11th victory in a row. The 149-pounder has gone 6-0 in EWL dual meets this season.

Facing one of the taller tasks of the evening, sophomore **Seth Martin (Selinsgrove, Pa./Selinsgrove)** succumbed to No. 10 Chris Horning 9-0, shortening the Bald Eagle lead to 16-8.

At 165, Mikeska got a takedown in the final five seconds to avoid sudden-victory and snag the 5-3 decision. The Golden Eagles were then deducted a point by the referee for arguing, bringing the score to 19-7. The deduction, combined with the knowledge of another Clarion forfeit at 184 would clinch the win for LHU.

Sophomore **Carlos Ponce (Hialeah, Fla./Hialeah Miami Lakes)** had an aggressive move in the first 25 seconds that knocked out Chris Goings, causing an injury default victory. Sophomore **Mike Metzger (Reading, Pa./Governor Mifflin)** then followed with a forfeit win.

At 197, Hepburn scored an escape in the last minute to win the tightly-contested 3-2 bout over Charlie Cilinski. The win improved Hepburn to 13-12 on the year.

And in the final bout of the day, Nagel entered the final period

with a 3-2 advantage. After stalling points given to each side, and with Nagel staring down the barrel of the riding time severely in opponent John Fager's favor, he got a step out with two seconds left for the 5-4 win.

The win gives LHU victories in nine out of the last 10 meetings with Clarion.

Scouting the EWL

With 10 ranked matmen, this year's EWL tournament will be highly-contested. Edinboro and West Virginia split last year's team title, and with the logjam at the top of the EWL standings this season, it is sure to come down to the wire once again.

At 125, with last year's champion and runner-up having graduated, 2004 third-place winner DeAngelo Penn of CSU leads a pack of hungry newcomers.

The battle at 133 shows No. 1 Shawn Bunch as favorite.

141 boasts two ranked matmen, Sophomore No. 8 Ron Tarquino of Pittsburgh and Clarion junior Frank Edgar. Tarquino took last year's title, while Edgar is sure to challenge the reigning champ.

At 149, 2004 champion Deonte Penn of Edinboro returns to defend his title.

157 should be the marquee weight class, as three ranked matmen look to vye for the title. No. 10 Chris Horning of host Clarion returns, having won last year's trophy. No. 7 Matt Lebe of WVU and Pittsburgh's No. 19 Matt Kocher will look to unseat Horning.

No. 11 senior Nate Yetzer of Edinboro is the sure favorite at 165 this season, with third-place finisher in 2004 Zachariah Doll

being the top returner.

At 174, Bloomsburg's No. 14 Bryce Hasseman and No. 20 Eric Ring of Edinboro are the ranked grapplers. Yetzer took the EWL title a year ago and has moved down to 165, leaving it wide open for any challenger.

At 184, No. 1 Greg Jones continues to be one of the top wrestlers in EWL history, and also is returning champ at this weight class.

197 is another class up for grabs, as 2004 third-place finisher Joe Phillips of Cleveland State and fifth-place Chad Hoare return with former national qualifier LHU's **Morgan Horner (Hasbrouck Heights, N.J./Hasbrouck Heights)** increasing the competition.

Heavyweight is another competitive class, Edinboro's Joe Hennis was a runner-up in 2004, and will be looked upon to take that extra step.

Last Time at the EWL Championship

The Lock Haven wrestling team placed seventh overall at the 2004 EWL held in Bloomsburg, Pa. The Bald Eagles had one automatic and two wild card national qualifiers in the two-day event as senior **Mike Maney** claimed his fourth career trip to the NCAA championship with the automatic bid after placing third at 149 pounds. **Jason Gilligan** and **Charlie Brenneman** both received wild card nods to wrestle at the national tournament.

Edinboro and West Virginia wrestled to a tie for the team championship, both squads boasting 99.50 points. Pittsburgh was a close third with 97.50 points, while Cleveland State (80.50) and Bloomsburg (79) followed in fourth and fifth place. Clarion (70) was sixth, Lock Haven (57.50) was seventh and Virginia Tech (44.50) rounded out the field in eighth place. Edinboro's Matt King (165 lbs.) was named the Outstanding Wrestler.

Four Bald Eagles advanced to the consolation finals to wrestle for an automatic spot at the national tournament, with one emerg-

ing with the guaranteed ticket. Maney secured his fourth trip to the NCAA championships with his third-place finish at 149 pounds. Maney, who had dropped down into the consolations after a semifinal loss, won his first bout in the lower bracket with a 2-0 decision over Bloomsburg's Brad Forbes. He then faced West Virginia's Mike Torriero in the third-place match, edging out the Mountaineer, 8-5. Maney had trailed, 4-3, entering into the third period but he unrolled a four-point move with a takedown and quick back points to bounce out into a 7-4 lead. Maney held Torriero down the remainder of the period, the Mountaineer picking up a stall point, but with the addition of riding time, the senior Bald Eagle claimed the 8-5 win.

**Jim Collins**, Gilligan and **Mike Greenberg (Canton/Canton)** all brought home fourth-place finishes.
