### **Teacher Education Programs**

#### **Exit Criteria**

- Successful completion of Candidacy Criteria (includes Stage I elements of the Teacher Education Assessment Plan). Stage I includes completion of the Communication and Disposition Self-evaluation, the Diversity Profile Plan, Evidence of passed Praxis One Exams (Reading, Writing, and Math), and the Technology Self-assessment.
- Successful completion of the Developing Portfolio Requirements in LiveText (Stage II of the Teacher Education Assessment Plan). The Developing Portfolio requirements include the following: “C-” or better in Math, Science, Speech, Composition, and History courses, sixty hours of field experience, twenty diversity hours and reflective essay, and a portfolio presentation and reflection.
- Successful completion of all General Education Requirements including “overlays”
- Successful completion of all Major Program Requirements with a “C” or better
- Successful completion of the Professional Semester Application and requirements for admittance to the Professional Semester
- Successful professional semester evaluations of lesson plans, communication skills, and dispositions
- Completion of the Praxis Two Series Exams
- Successful completion of Student Teaching requirements with a “C” or better in each placement
- Successful evaluation on PDE Form 430 forms
- Successful completion of a Senior Portfolio in LiveText
- Successful completion of a Teacher Work Sample during student teaching
- Successful evaluation of communication skills and dispositions during student teaching
- Successful maintenance of required 3.0 GPA
- Completion of Application for Graduation with academic advisor and department chair signatures
- The recommendation of the Lock Haven University Teacher Certification Officer
