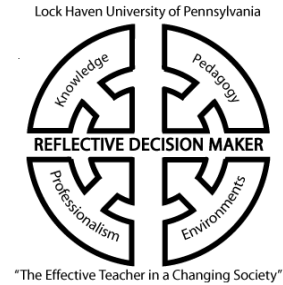

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LOCATIONS

Students who expect to be certified by LHUP must student teach at schools where the University has an affiliation agreement (contract) with the district/agency and is able to supervise. Students who reside in the residence halls or elsewhere in the Lock Haven area will be placed in schools in any of the districts from Milton to Bald Eagle Area and Bellefonte Area, including Lock Haven and Renovo. Those students who commute will be placed in and around Lock Haven and in districts nearer to their homes, if sites and supervisors are available. Requests for specific teachers are not accepted.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

CLEARANCES: Prior to beginning student teaching and to obtain a teaching position in Pennsylvania, you must present a current negative TB test, a Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance (Act 151), a Pennsylvania Criminal Record Check (Act 34) and the FBI Clearance. **DEADLINE FOR CLEARANCES:** As described in separate documents, you must present the ORIGINAL of these documents to the Clearance Coordinator in Robinson Learning Center, Room 613 by 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 24, 2009. Clearances must be valid through May 5, 2010 **When you present the originals to Mrs. Cozzi, please bring a copy of all of the clearances for us to place in your file.**

As an Applicant for Student Teaching I understand that

- It is my responsibility to be fully aware of the need for current legal "clearances" and to file these in an appropriate and timely manner with the Clearance Coordinator, located in Robinson Learning Center, Room 613;
- It is my responsibility to meet ALL course and grade prerequisites for Student Teaching.
- It is my responsibility to register for all student teaching courses for my program before the placement meeting held in December. You will not receive your student teaching placements at the meeting if you have not registered for the appropriate courses.
- It is my responsibility to have attempted all Praxis II tests (all required of your program) prior to the first day of student teaching. Evidence of the tests scores or the admission ticket must be presented to Dr. Allen or Mrs. Blesh before January 11, 2010 in order for you to start your first student teaching placement on January 18, 2010.
- It is my responsibility to have passed all required PRAXIS exams before LHUP will process my application for certification.
- It is my responsibility to inform, immediately, the Director of Student teaching if there are any changes in the information contained in my application;
- It is my responsibility to purchase liability insurance prior to beginning my first student teaching placement. The evidence of liability insurance must be shown to the university supervisor at the first practicum session.
- It is my responsibility to have all of my clearances in my possession and readily available if a person asks to see them before or during the student teaching placements.
